# Voters can still register for elections

Voters wishing to vote for everything from party candidates for President of the United States to Lane County Sheriff will be able to register to vote before 8 p.m. Tuesday.

Persons who are not yet registered may do so by going to the

Lane County Elections office on Seventh Avenue and Pearl Street in Eugene. The elections office will issue a registration card which must be taken to the polling place Tuesday so the vote can be counted. Identification must be presented to the elections office before the registration card will be

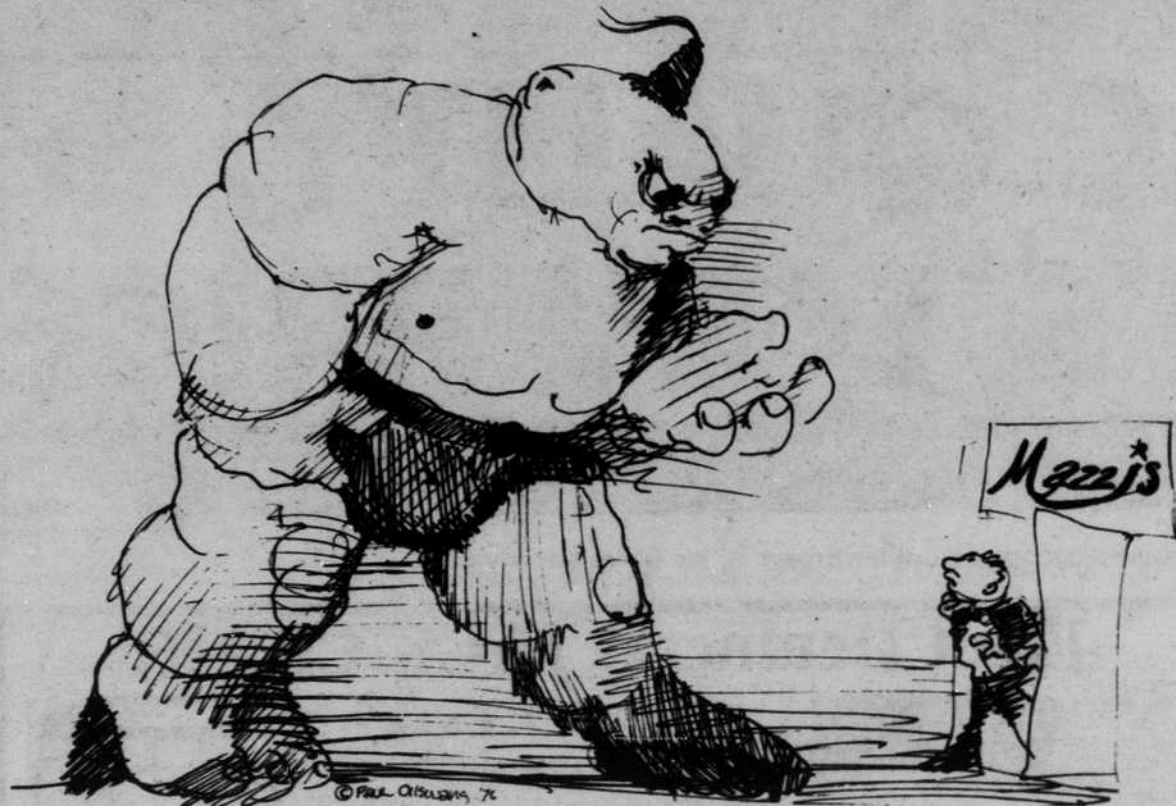
issued.

The punch-card ballot system will be used in the primary election, and instructions for the operation of the system can be found in the front of the State of Oregon Voter's Pamphlet. Persons at polling places will also assist if there are any problems.

Write-in votes for candidates

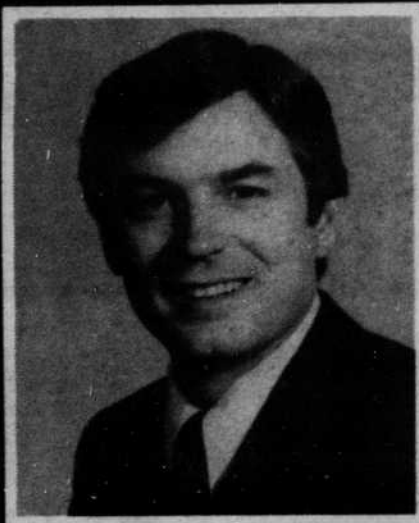
must be written on the envelope in which the ballot is received. On the envelope will be a section headlined by "Write-in ballot." The name of the candidate and the office the candidate is running for must be written in this section. If another candidate has been punched on the ballot, the vote will not be counted.
