

Butz resigns Agriculture post

WASHINGTON (AP) — Pres. Ford accepted the resignation of his secretary of agriculture Monday and said parting with Earl Butz was "one of the saddest decisions of my presidency."

The resignation followed a weekend of

rapidly escalating controversy over an obscene racial slur uttered last August following the Republican National Convention and traced to Butz last week.

The episode had become an issue in Ford's election campaign and brought

numerous demands from politicians in both parties that Butz be fired. The lingering question was whether Ford had waited too long.

Both Butz and the President said the resignation did not mean any policy change.

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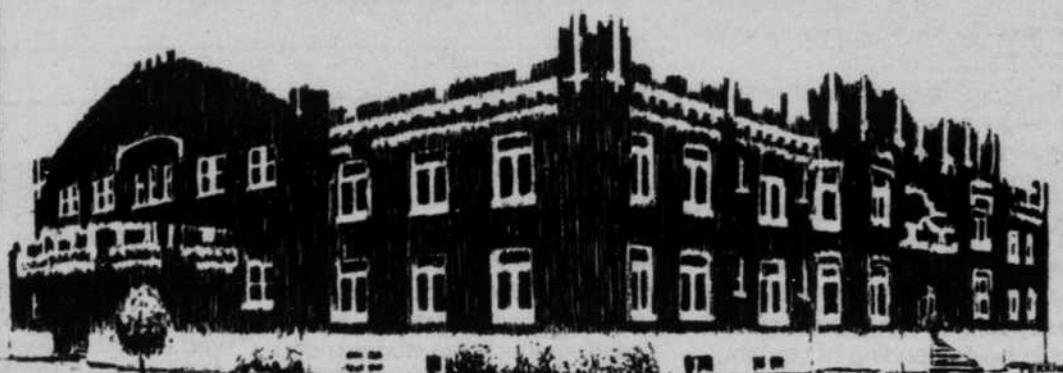
