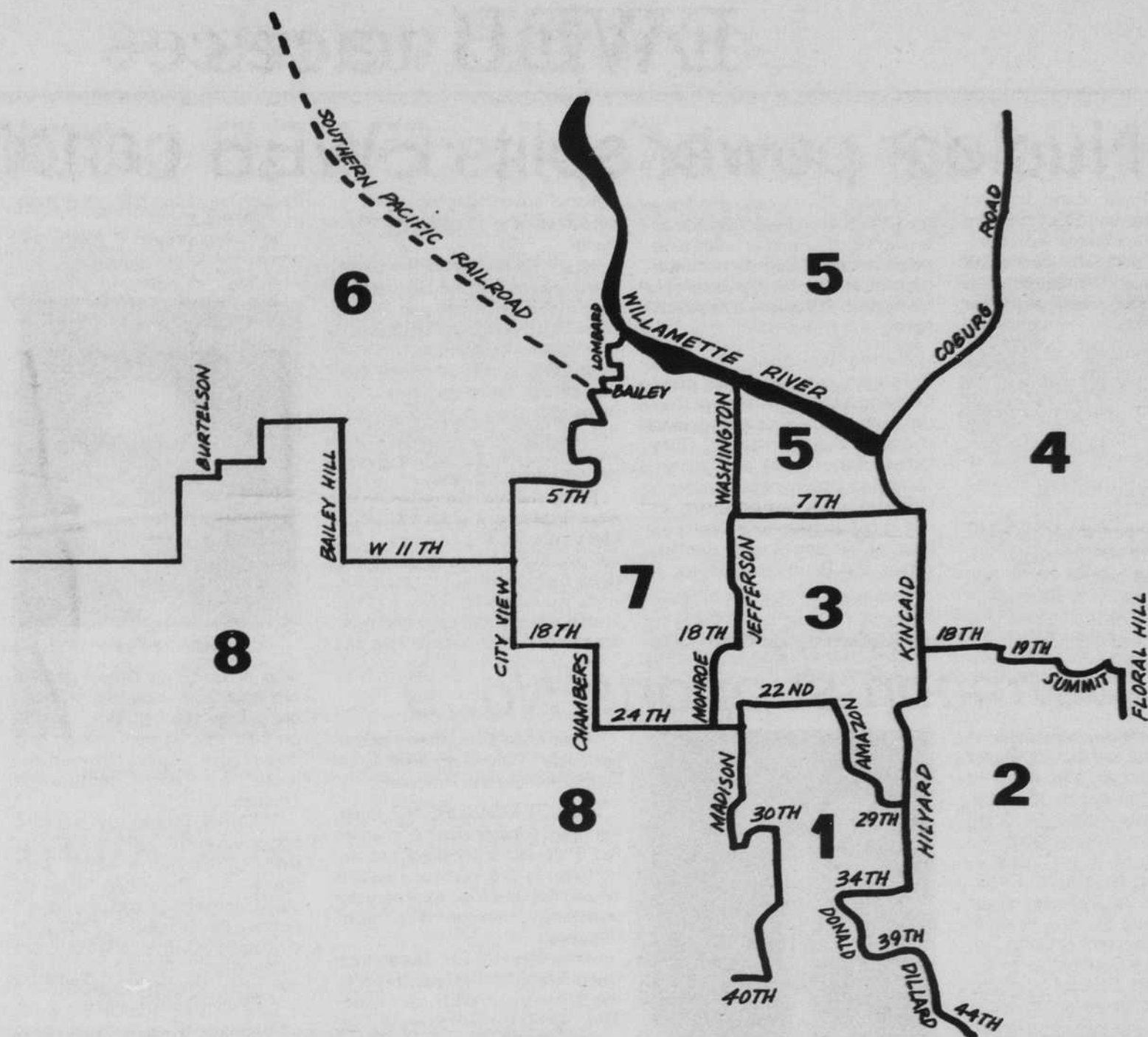


City Ward Map

Open letter from John Reynolds, retiring EWEB Commissioner, Wards 2 & 3

I'd like to tell you why I believe Camilla Pratt is so clearly the better qualified candidate for EWEB, Wards 2 and 3. Camilla and her opponent are both intelligent people who have the best interests of EWEB in mind — there the similarity ends.

Unlike her opponent, Camilla has attended EWEB meetings since September 1974, gaining insights into the working of our Board that are impossible to achieve in any other way. Camilla knows the issues well, and will be an effective member of the Board from its first session in January 1977. Believe me, there is no substitute for over two years of meetings!

Unlike her opponent, Camilla has worked with the EWEB staff and the other members of the Joint Energy Conservation Council, helping get the message about energy conservation to the public. The mutual respect built over time between Camilla and EWEB's staff will be of great help during her service on the Board.

Unlike her opponent, Camilla clearly and strongly supports Ballot Measure 9, the Nuclear Safeguards Initiative. Recent elections have shown that 50% of Eugene has serious questions about relying on today's nuclear plants; yet the Board remains 4-1 pro-nuclear. To maintain perspective at EWEB, we must have at least one Board member who is both thoroughly informed and articulate on the dangers of relying on nuclear power. Camilla is clearly the better person for this job.

Voters of Wards 2 and 3, if you agree with what I've tried to do for EWEB in these past four years, then join me in voting for Camilla Pratt, to keep EWEB moving in a positive direction.
