

Housing project planned for elderly

Construction on a 150 unit high-rise apartment building for the elderly should begin by early summer, according to Robin Cushman, housing expeditor with the Department of Housing and Community Conservation of Eugene.

The project, which was initiated by the National Benevolent Association (NBA) of the First Christian Church, will be financed by the Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) which will also provide tenant rent subsidies. Under the plan, a tenant will pay 25 per cent of his monthly income for rent,

with the federal government paying the remainder of the market rent of the unit.

The Eugene Renewal Agency refused permission of the original construction site on 11th Avenue and Willamette Street because of a previous commitment to retail development. The NBA has agreed to an option building site on the southeast corner of 11th Avenue and Olive Street.

The NBA's next hurdle is the city's Zoning Board of Appeals where they will "request permission for a substantial reduction in the city's parking requirements" according to Cushman.

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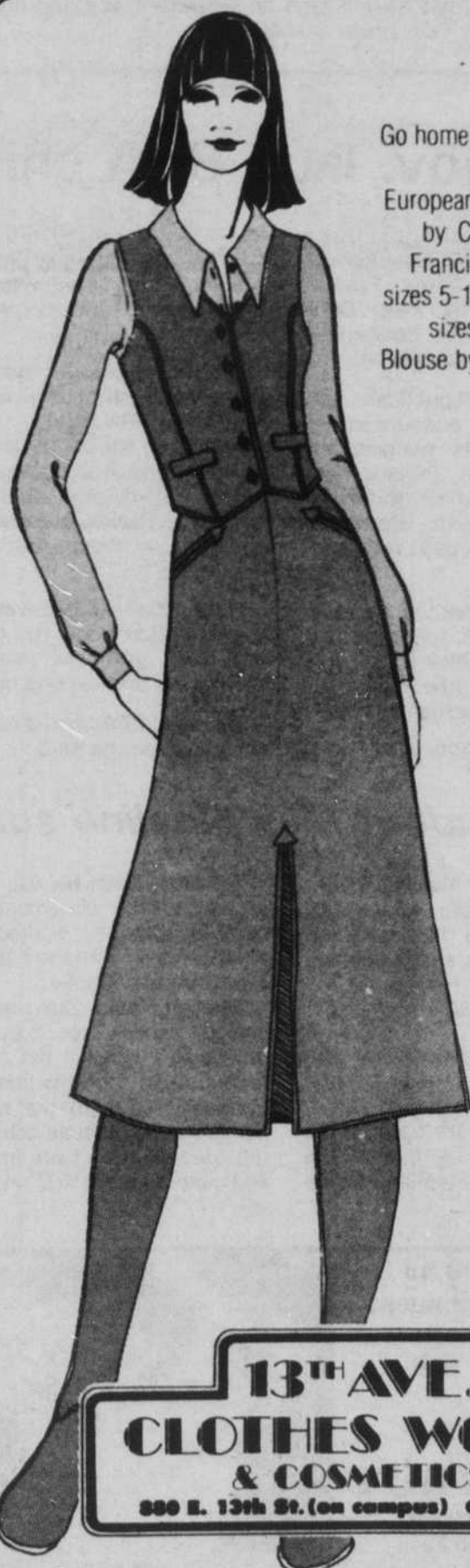


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
