lieved that it's over. I think the process had a positive influence." Grannel said he may support adding members to the Rules Committee although he voted against Chrest's motion. "There probably should be a person from an urban area on the committee," he added.

At present, the committee consists of representatives Grannel; Ed Lindquist, D-Milwaukee, who chairs the committee; Ted Kulonogski, D-Junction City; Minority Leader Roger Martin, R-Lake Oswego; Gary Wilhelms, R-Klamath Falls, and Dick Magruder, D-Clatskanie.

One of the most important issues still to be resolved is who will control the assignment of bills already on the Speaker's desk. Among those bills is a controver-

sial field burning bill, which will raise the number of acres of allowable burning this summer from 95,000 to 235,000 acres.

With the make-up of the new Rules Committee, some observers are speculating that the committee may assign the bill to the committee on Agriculture and Natural Resources, where it is likely to pass. Lang contends that he has the power to assign bills now on his desk, and observers say he may assign the bill to the Environment and Energy Committee, where it is expected to die.

Another speculation flying through the halls of the capitol is that Lang may resign his post. In a press conference Wednesday, Lang said he would not resign as Speaker, but he declined to comment Thursday after the failure of the motion to restore his powers.
