

Information center provides free drug tests

Among the services provided by the University's Drug Information Center (DIC) is a free drug analysis service. Each month the center releases a report on the samples received from University students during that month.

According to DIC staffers, this service is not intended to condone usage, but rather to make information available and to allow the facts to speak for themselves. Any person wishing to have a drug analyzed should call the DIC at 686-5411 between 9 a.m. and 5 p.m. Monday through Friday. The center asks that no samples be brought into the office.

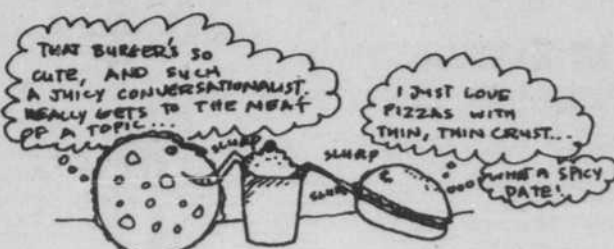
