Professors do research on employee turnovers

The results of a training technique developed from a study now underway at the University show that the technique may lead to better retention of employees.

Richard Steers, a University associate professor of management, conducted the study last year in 108 branches of a California bank. The bankers were divided into two groups. Fifty-four bank supervisors were sent to a two-day workshop where they were instructed in dealing more efficiently and effectively with employees. The other 54 supervisors were given no instruction.

The turnover rate among employees of all 108 branches was monitored for nine months after the workshop. According to Steers, the turnover rate for the 54 branches whose supervisors participated in the workshop had significantly decreased.

Steers recently received a \$236,000 award from the Office of Naval Research to continue his research. The award, a three-year contract, is a renewal of a two-year contract Steers previously held.
