I mean, Nick's been trying to

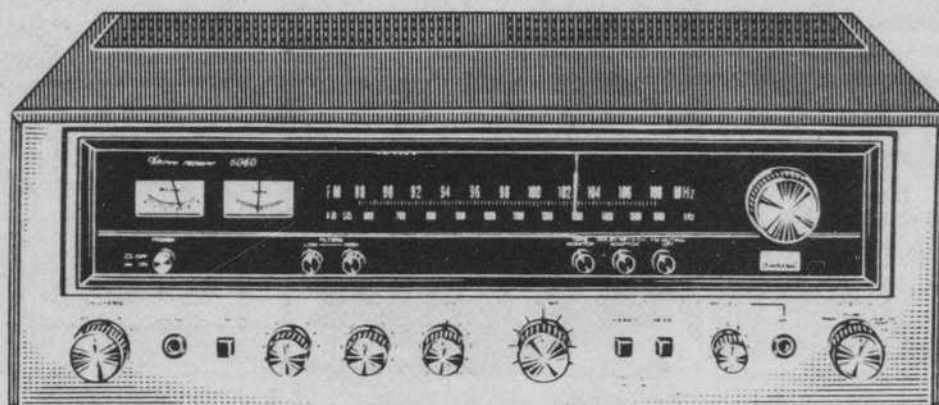
