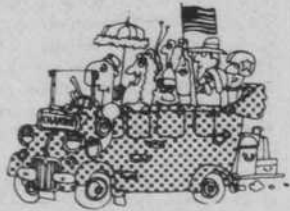

Advocacy director files for state rep against Frohnmayer

Don Chalmers, office of student advocacy director, has officially filed to challenge Republican David Frohnmayer congressional seat representing District 40, the South Eugene area.

In filing for the May 23 primary election Chalmers, a 27-year-old Democrat, said "I have concluded that District 40 needs new representation."

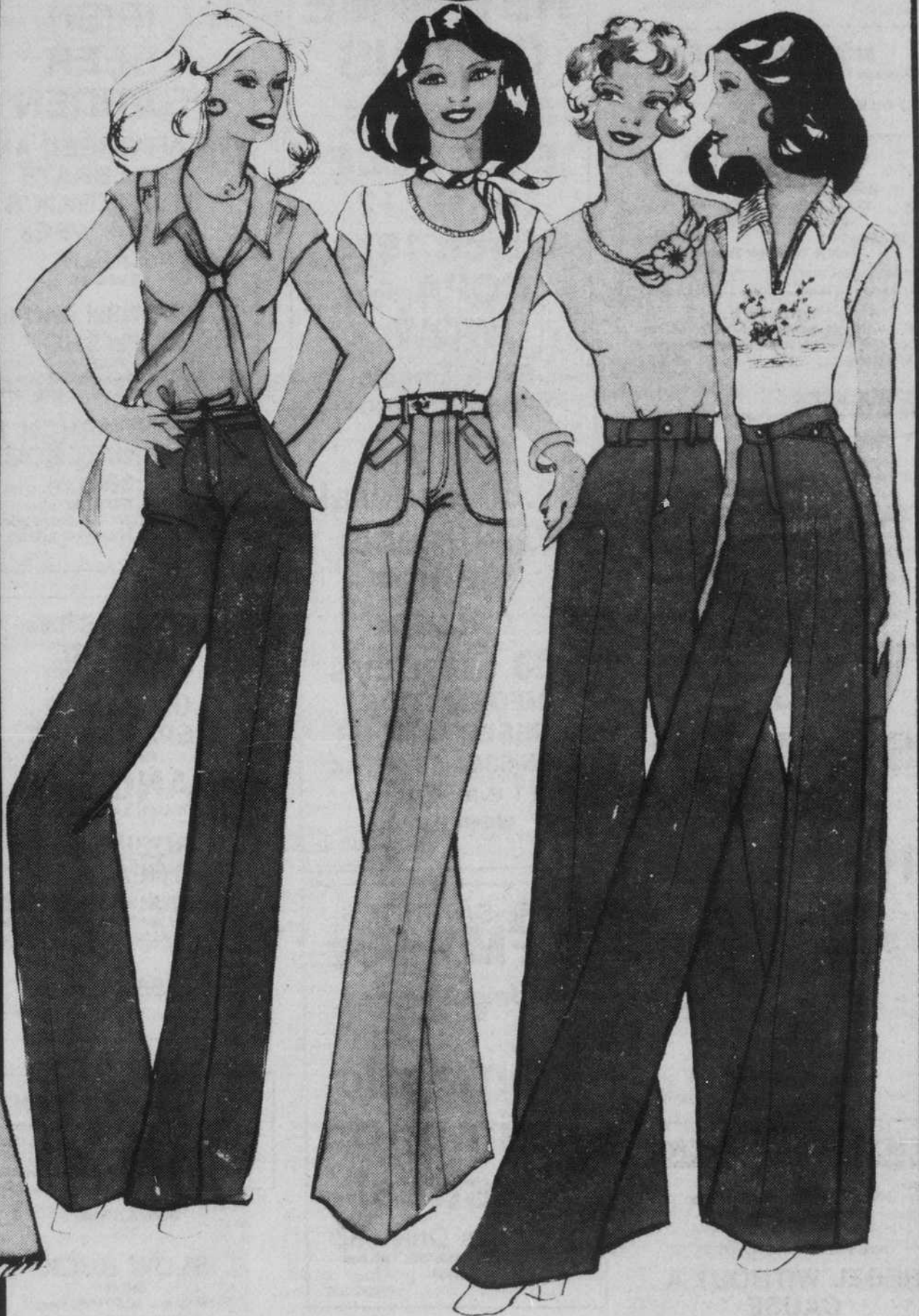
Chalmers hasn't been a student since 1975, but has worked administering student affairs for

about three years. He says this puts him in a good position for the race.

Chalmers graduated from the University law school in 1975 and began working as a consultant on government projects for a variety of clients, including the University. He served as a legislative lobbyist and has directed the office of student advocacy since 1976.
