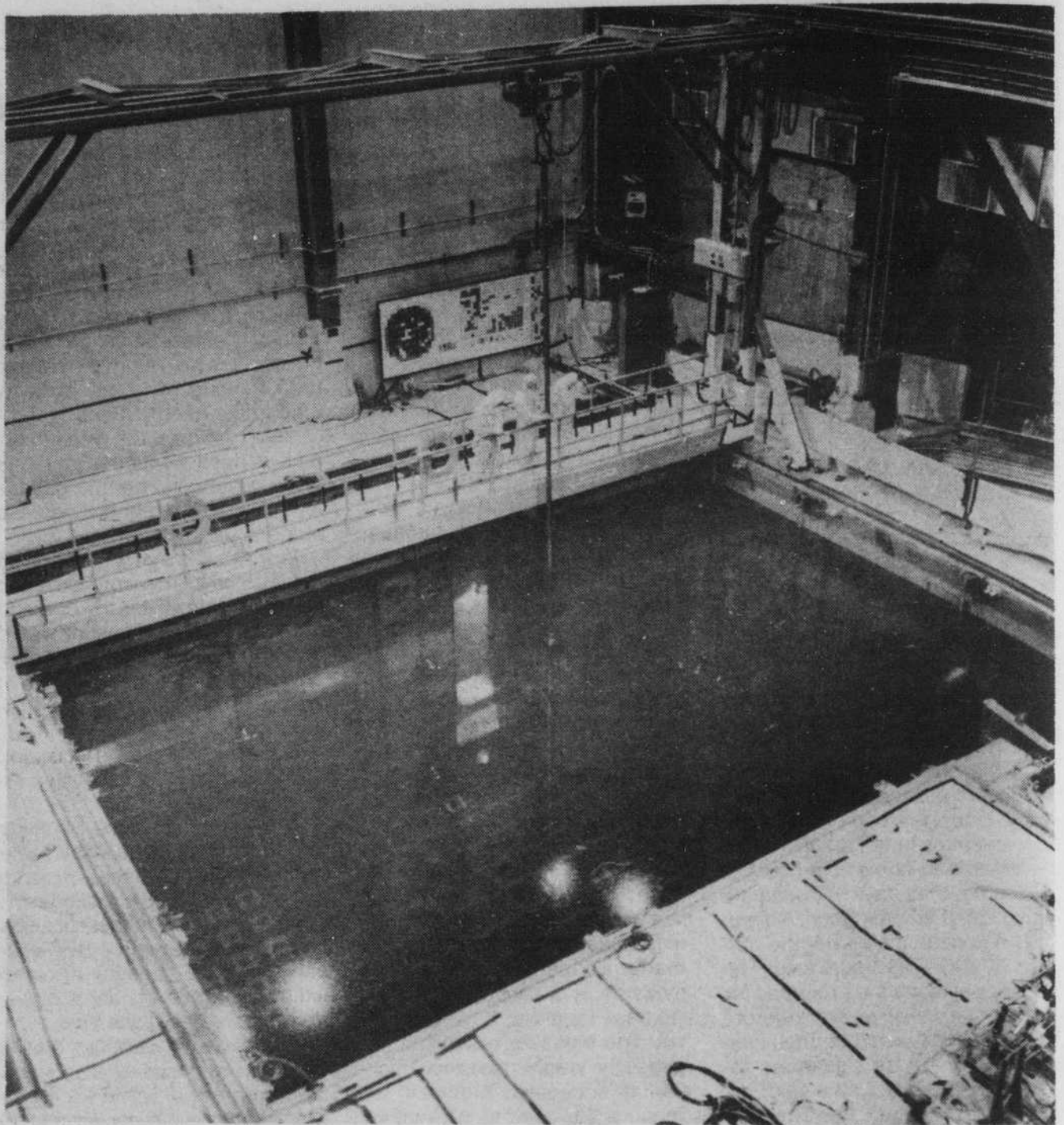
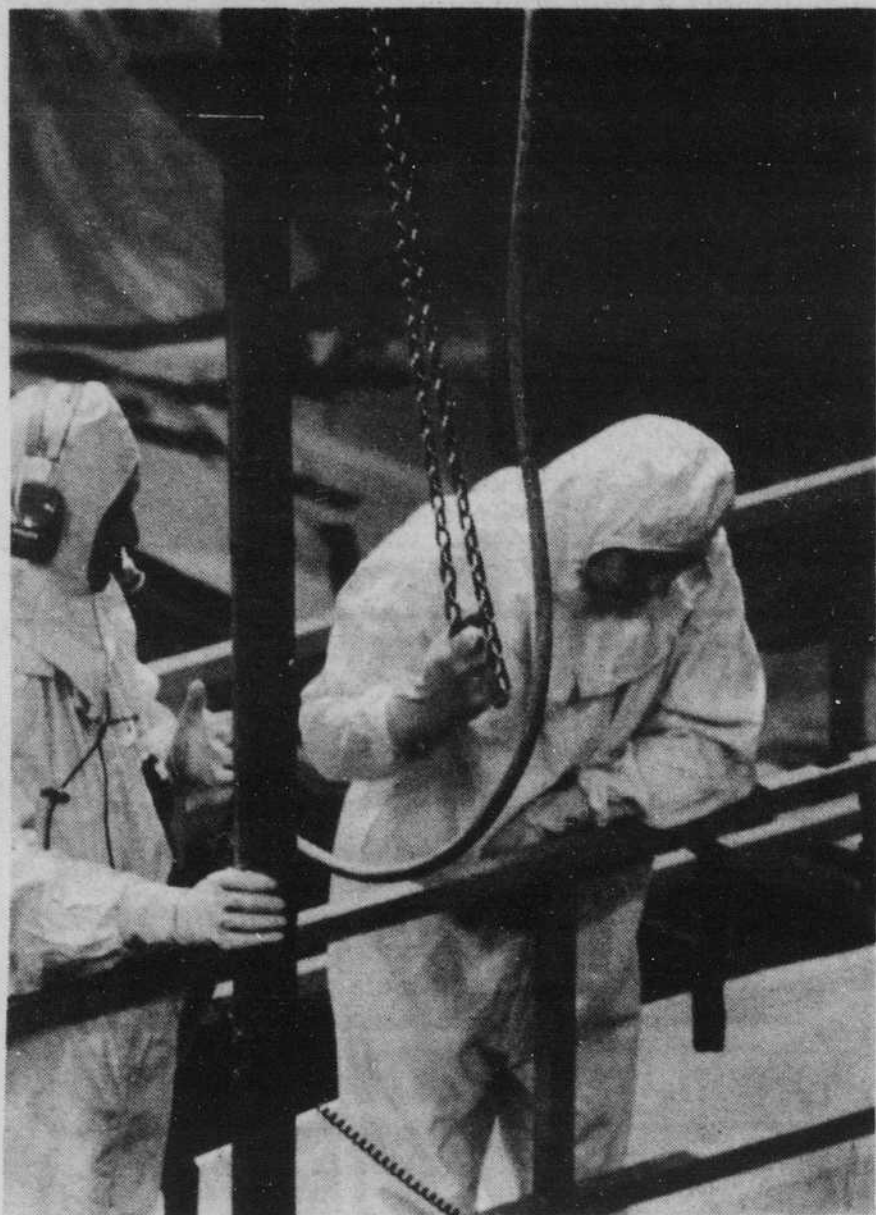

\$500,000 refueling process means working 20 hours a day

Workers cluster around an overhead crane as they stand on a catwalk above the spent fuel storage pond at the Trojan Nuclear Power Plant. The pool is waiting to receive one of 64 spent-fuel storage assemblies into its racks.

The \$500,000 refueling process involves technicians, in protective yellow suits, working 20 hours a day to move the 1600-pound radioactive fuel assemblies into the 48-foot

deep storage pool. The glowing spots in the pond are visible, dark blue radiation, known as the Cerenkov effect.

This is the first refueling for the Trojan plant — future refuelings will be on an annual basis. The plant, near Rainier, Oregon, is owned by Portland General Electric Co., the Eugene Water and Electric Board and Pacific Power and Light.
