The council is composed of State Treasurer Clay Myers and four other persons. The council hires, fires and advises its investment managers, but does not direct its managers to invest or not to invest in any particular companies, according to Lyndon Wilson, deputy state treasurer.

Redden said political factors could be only considered in buying and selling state stock if it affected the return on those investments.

Otherwise Redden said only two principles — the safety of investments and the probable rate of return could influence the investment managers to sell stock.

The attorney general's opinion is legally binding unless it is overruled in court.

A demonstration at the capitol building in Salem is also planned for May 19.
