

Grandma wants death penalty restored

SALEM, (AP) — The grandmother of an 11-year-old murder victim wants to see the death penalty restored in Oregon.

Elsie Pettingill, 53, Salem, grandmother of Stephanie Newsom, has been circulating petitions to get a death penalty bill on the November ballot.

More than 46,000 signatures are needed by July 7.

The sponsors are Reps. Jack Sumner, D-Heppner; Bernard

Byers, D-Lebanon; and Cecil Johnson, R-Grants Pass.

The measure would allow a judge to sentence murderers to die in a gas chamber, the same method used when Oregon had the death penalty for 50 years before it was abolished in 1964.

Pettingill is the mother of Carl Newson, father of Stephanie. The girl was abducted April 19 in West Salem. Her body was found eight days later on the Ankeny National

Wildlife Refuge 10 miles south of Salem. She had been strangled.

Police apparently have few clues on a suspect.

"I spent all day Monday walking up and down streets in Salem and I got more than 70 signatures,"

Pettingill said. "Only three people turned me down."

"I consider myself a Christian," she said. "But I think the death penalty has to be put back in so our children will be safe and others won't have to go through what our family has the last few

weeks."

"I've always felt the death penalty should be used, and after Stephanie died my feelings were even stronger about it," she said.

Pettingill said she doesn't believe the death penalty should be imposed for all murder.
