Waters, McGregor play this weekend at The Place

Muddy Waters, one of the most influential and revered electric blues guitarists of all time, will be performing at The Place Friday and Saturday.

Known for such classics as "Got My Mojo Working," "I'm Your Hoochie Coochie Man," "I Can't Be Satisfied," "Honey Bee," "Long Distance Call," "Trouble No More," "Rollin' Stone," and "Baby, Please Don't Go," Waters has had a major impact on virtually every contemporary white blues singer in the last decade.

Recording with Waters have been such people as Paul Butterfield, Mike Bloomfield, Rory Gallagher, Levon Helm, Garth Hudson, James Cotton and Johnny Winters.

Waters, who just turned 63, was born and raised in Mississippi. He began playing guitar at 17, imitating some of the old blues masters like Eddie "Son" House and Robert Johnson.

His earliest recordings, made for the Library of Congress in 1941 and 1942, are marked by complex bottleneck guitar and the raw force of delta blues. He recorded "Rollin' Stone" in 1954, and became an early influence on Jimi Hendrix.

Waters has a long string of awards. He took a Grammy Award for *They Call Me Muddy Waters* in 1971, a Billboard Magazine Trendsetter Award in 1971, another Grammy in 1973 for the *London Muddy Waters Sessions*, and was elected to Ebony

Magazine's Black Music Hall of Fame in 1973.

He has also won numerous awards for appearances at institutions and corrective rehabilitation centers.

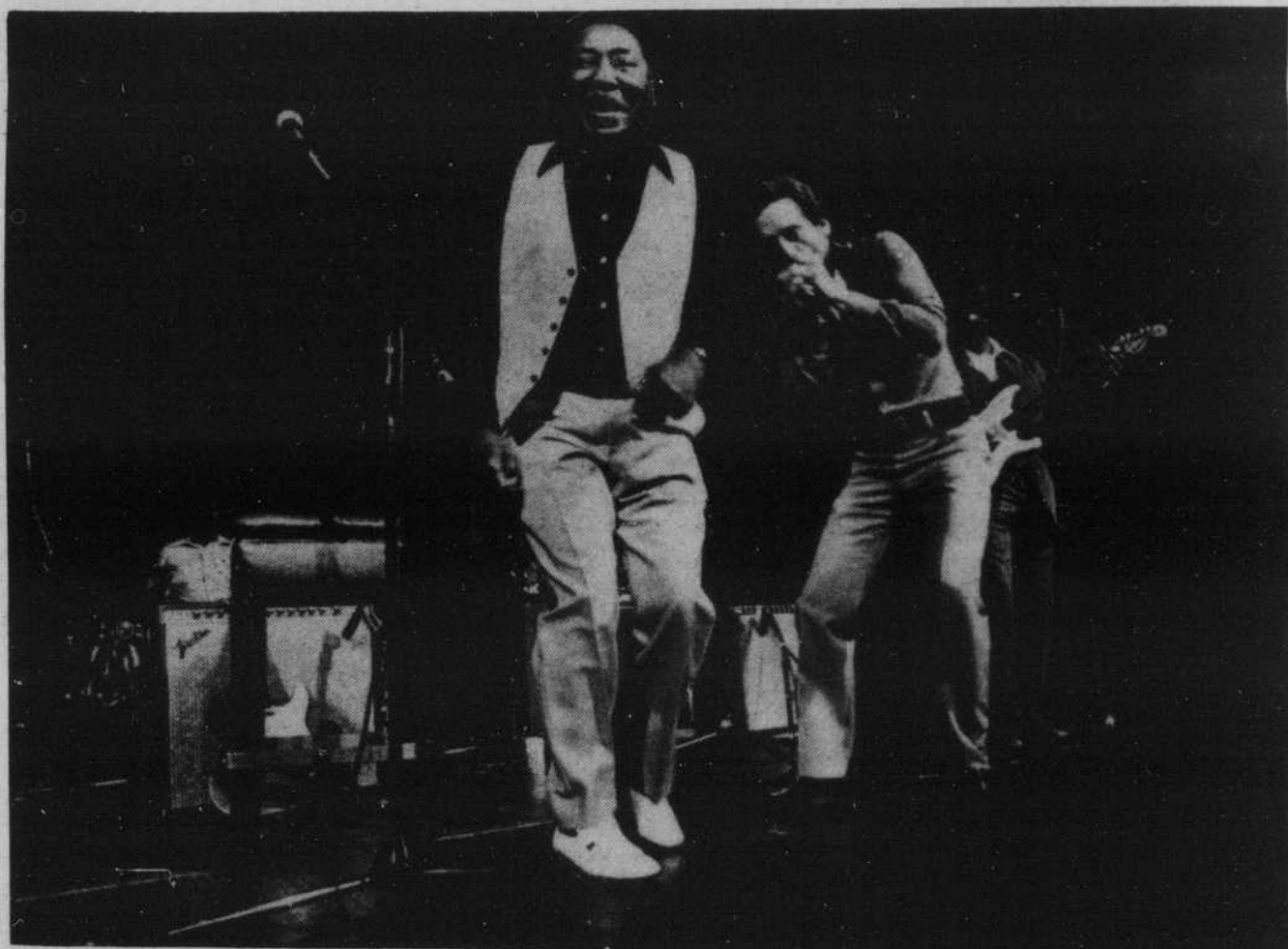
Some of his most popular albums have been *Live at Newport*, *They Call Me Muddy Waters*, *The London Muddy Waters Sessions*,
