

There's still time to register to vote

It's possible to register to vote in the May 23 election until Tuesday at 5 p.m. Residents must go in person to the Lane County Elections Division, 175 W. 8th Ave., to register and to receive their certificates, which must be presented at polling places.

To be eligible to vote in Oregon, residents must have lived in Oregon for twenty days prior to the election. It's necessary for registered voters to register if there has been an address change since the previous registration.

Registered democrats vote for democratic candidates, non-partisan candidates and ballot measures. Republicans vote for republican candidates, non-partisan candidates and ballot measures. Non-partisan and independent voters vote only for non-partisan races and ballot measures.

Although there are 31 candidates on the ballot for the three Lane County Commissioner races, Eugene's South and North Commissioners Districts will not vote for commissioner candidates. Commissioners Archie Weinstein (North) and Jerry Rust (South) positions do not expire until 1980.

There will be five commissioner candidates on the Springfield District ballot, 12 on the West Lane District ballot and 14 on the East Lane District ballot.

The polls will be open from 8 a.m. to 8 p.m. Tuesday. Eugene and Springfield polling locations are:
