human with the guards as we are with ourselves," she says.
At 8 a.m. a marine color guard emerges to raise the flag. A support person whips out a kazoo and launches into a spirited rendition of the Marine Corps Hymn.
He is joined by 100 vocalists. They are stopped by a "peacekeeper," who says, "We're not here to ridicule the Marines or anyone else."
As the last occupants are removed (they are the "Peaceful Alternatives," a Eugene group) the smiles on their faces are visible from one-half mile away.
In the windows of the offices further in the background, more faces are visible, but the expressions are obscured, perhaps by the iron grating over the windows.

The Trident system will cost 30 billion by 1982, with a fleet of 30 submarines to be completed by 1990. The advanced Trident missile, with its multiple warhead missiles, will assure pinpoint accuracy at a range of up to 6000

miles, and under present conditions would be virtually invulnerable, according to the U.S. Navy.
The fundamental argument against Trident is offered by Robert Aldridge, a scientist who worked on the project until he quit because he was convinced Trident was being developed as a first strike weapon. Like most Americans, he said he had believed the nuclear arsenal was to serve as a deterrent force.

In an article in this month's Progressive, Aldridge catalogues such weapons systems as laser beam anti-missile satellites (first test — '82), anti satellite missiles (developed in secret) and worldwide anti-submarine sonar tracking.
He concludes the U.S. will have a "successful" first strike capability by 1985. He points to statements by Presidents Ford and Carter in which each failed to rule out on principle a first strike against the Soviets.
