## Bullets bite back, 106-98, to tie series

LANDOVER, Md. (AP) — Bob Dandridge and Elvin Hayes, goats in Washington's opening-game loss, combined for 59 points and led the Bullets to a 106-98 victory over the Seattle SuperSonics Thursday night, tying the National Basketball Association championship series 1-1.

It was the first victory for the Bullets in 10 championship games. The Bullets had been swept by Milwaukee in 1971 and Golden State in 1975.

The third game of the best-of-seven series will be played Sunday at the Capital Centre, where the Bullets have won 10 in a row, including eight in the playoffs.

With a sellout crowd of 19,035 urging them on, the Bullets opened a 24-10 lead after eight minutes. During that stretch, Dan-

dridge scored two more points than the six he had in Game 1.

But the SuperSonics, who overcame a 19-point deficit to win last Sunday, stormed back again after trailing 37-21 early in the second quarter, with Dennis Johnson pacing the rally.

Dandridge scored 20 points in the first half, which ended with Washington ahead 56-52, and finished with 34. Hayes, who scored 21 points in the opener but was scoreless in the fourth quarter, scored 25 points, including 12 in the third quarter.

Gus Williams paced Seattle with 24 points and Johnson had 19. Fred Brown, who scored 30 points in the first game, managed only 10 after shooting 1-for-5 in the first half.

Marvin Webster, Seattle's

7-foot-1 center, collided with Mitch Kupchak while trying to block his stuff shot in the second quarter and fell heavily to the floor. Webster held his left side the remainder of the game and scored only 10 points.

Seattle hit only three of its first 14 shots as Washington opened up the 24-10 lead, but the SuperSonics rallied in the second quarter even while being outshot from the floor, 55 to 48 percent.

During that stretch, however, Washington center Wes Unseld was on the bench for all but two minutes of the period and the Bullets managed only four rebounds during the quarter.

Unseld, criticized by Dandridge and Hayes during the week for his lack of offense, scored his only basket late in the game. But the

veteran, who was on the previous two teams which lost in the championship round, was an important factor with 15 rebounds and five assists.

Washington guard Tom Henderson scored 20 points while hitting eight of 11 shots and also was credited with five assists.

The SuperSonics, who led only 2-0, pulled within 56-54 at the outset of the second half and several times closed within three points thereafter.

Leading 66-63, the Bullets went on a 10-2 tear to go ahead 76-65. Hayes scored six of the points and

blocked a shot by Jack Sikma which led to a basket by Dandridge.

A three-point play by Williams and two baskets by Brown cut Washington's lead to 96-90 with 3:47 left.

But a field goal and two foul shots by Dandridge, and two more free throws by Henderson, widened Washington's advantage to 102-92 and shut off the SuperSonics.

The Bullets now have a 21-0 record at home this season while playing before crowds in excess of 12,000.

## Montreal needs its best game to beat Bruins and take crown

BOSTON (AP) — The Montreal Canadiens, drenched with champagne from the National Hockey League's Stanley Cup, called their victory over the Boston Bruins the toughest in years.

"They are alley fighters," said Montreal's speedy Steve Shutt, after the Canadiens had clinched their third consecutive championship with a 4-1 victory Thursday night, taking the series 4-2.

"This is the toughest team we've played," said Montreal Coach Scotty Bowman.

The Canadiens' star defenseman Larry Robinson, winner of the Conn Smythe Trophy as the most valuable player in the playoffs, alluded to expectations that the powerful Canadiens would sweep the best-of-seven series against

Boston as they did a year ago.

"This was our toughest final series. After we lost two games here, everyone was down on us," Robinson said. "But it's always more gratifying to win when you face so much difficulty."

Yvan Cournoyer, a veteran of Stanley Cup competition and champagne, said, "You never get tired of it. Every year is different and you have to have great teams every time to win."

In the subdued Boston dressing room, Bruins Coach Don Cherry conceded, "They have the strongest team in league. They had too much bench strength for us."

Boston goalie Gerry Cheevers, after forcing the Canadiens to a

sixth game, insisted "We were only inches away from the Cup, but we'll be that much better next year."

"They're not infallible," the Bruins goalie said. "It took their best game of the series to win tonight."

"It took 110 games for us to get that far," said Boston veteran Wayne Cashman, "and it will take another 110 to get us back. And we will be back."

"I'm glad it's over," Shutt said, "and I'm glad Mario Tremblay scored those goals. You could see the fire in his eyes."

Tremblay, who scored two goals in the sixth game, said, "It just was my night. It was our night."

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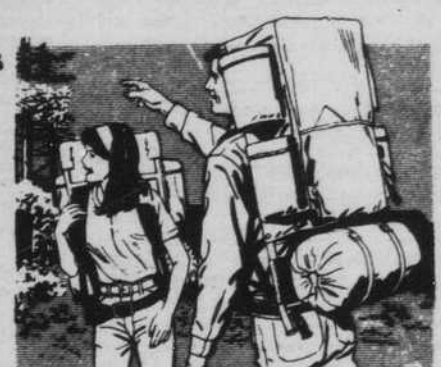
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
