

Terrorist suspects nabbed; one tied to Red Brigades

BONN, West Germany (AP) — Yugoslavia has seized four of West Germany's most-wanted terrorist suspects, including a woman with reported ties to the Red Brigades murderers of former Italian premier Aldo Moro, the Bonn government said Monday.

Informed sources said the two men and two women were captured in Yugoslavia May 11, on the same day that a fifth suspected German terrorist was seized at Orly airport in Paris before he could board a plane for Zagreb, Yugoslavia.

A Justice Ministry spokesman

said the four were among 20 alleged hard-core terrorists sought in a string of political murders, including last year's kidnap-slaying of industrialist Hanns-Martin Schleyer.

The sources, who asked not to be identified, said the terrorists were seized in an international dragnet that spanned East and West Europe.

German officials refused to give details of the Yugoslavia arrests.

Sepp Binder, the Justice Ministry spokesman, told a news conference Bonn has asked Belgrade

to extradite the four suspects — Brigitte Mohnhaupt, 28, Sieglinde Gutrun Hoffmann, 33, Rolf Clemens Wagner, 33, and Peter Boock, 26.

The suspect arrested in Paris, Stefan Werner Wisniewski, was nabbed at the airport with a ticket to Zagreb, Yugoslavia, in his pocket. All are suspected members of the terrorist Red Army Faction.

Binder said Yugoslavia has asked Bonn to arrest and deport an undisclosed number of persons wanted by the Belgrade government.

'Soldiers' attack army computer

ROME (AP) — Four men wearing military uniforms overpowered an unarmed guard at an army computer center and tried to blow it up but failed when a fuse connected to a gasoline can fizzled.

Police said they believed the attack Sunday was carried out by an ultra leftist organization called Communist Soldiers Nuclei, which has vowed to carry out attacks against Italian military centers.

In another attack, terrorists threw firebombs at an office of the Christian Democrat Party in Rome's densely populated Ostiense section. Police said no injuries were reported but that damage was heavy.

A caller told the Italian news agency ANSA the overnight attack was the work of a leftist group called Armed Proletariat Formations.

In the northern city of Turin, Pietro Bertolazzi, a member of the urban terrorist Red Brigades, on trial with 14 others on sedition charges, said today that a protest inside the Turin jail Saturday was a parallel action to a terrorist attack on a Berlin prison.

Alfa Romeo head convicted

MILAN, Italy — Gaetano Cortesi, president of Alfa Romeo, Italy's second-largest automaker, was convicted and sentenced Monday to a 40-day suspended jail term for labor law violations. Cortesi immediately resigned from his post, which he has held since 1974.

Three other executives of the state-run company also were sentenced to 40-day terms and their sentences were suspended.

The four were convicted of hiring workers for the Arese factory north of Milan without respecting union employment lists. The law requires new employees be drawn from government-approved union rolls.

White Zaire refugees flee

KINSHASA, Zaire — White refugees fearful of a new rebel invasion were reported fleeing Lubumbashi, capital of Shaba Province, as Zaire Pres. Mobutu Sese Seko flew to Morocco Monday to seek military reinforcements against the rebel threat.

Western diplomatic sources said two French cargo planes flew white women and children out of Lubumbashi on Sunday.

A Belgian Embassy spokesman in Kinshasa and French officials in Paris denied their governments were mounting an airlift of Europeans from the area. But the French Foreign Ministry confirmed that "a few dozen wives and children" had left Lubumbashi.

'Benedict Arnold' awarded

LOS ANGELES — California Gov. Edmund Brown Jr. has been awarded the "Benedict Arnold Citizenship Award" by 60 former prisoners of war for naming former anti-war activist Tom Hayden to a federally funded solar energy firm.

Calling themselves "The Concerned Former POW Caucus," the 60 were among 300 Vietnam POWs who gathered for a weekend reunion at a downtown hotel. The larger group disavowed any connection with the award.
