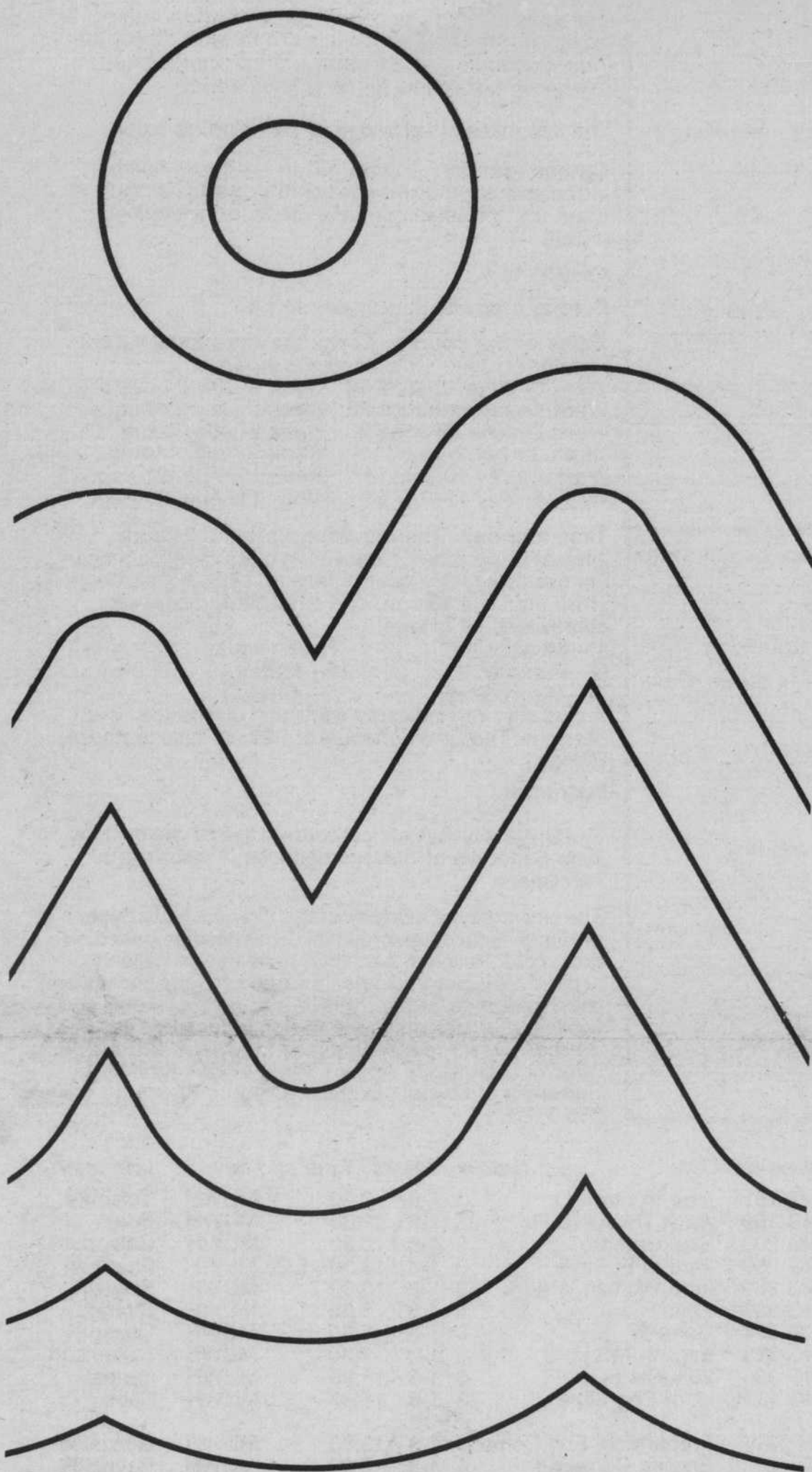




Enjoy an Oregon Summer

Who can take classes?

Anyone! During Summer Session you may take any courses limited only by prerequisites, if any, and space available, without being formally admitted. Further, the Community Education Program (CEP) is now available in summer. All former CEP participants who are not formally admitted to the University may continue taking classes during the Summer Session.

How do I sign up?

Fill out the registration request form on page 2 and return it to the Summer Session Office, Room 64, Prince Lucien Campbell Hall, University of Oregon, Eugene, Oregon 97403. Additional forms are available from Summer Session or the Registrar's Office. If your request form is received by June 14, a registration packet will be prepared and waiting for you during your priority hour at registration Monday, June 19.

Anyone not having a registration packet prepared in advance should proceed to the "Registrar's Table" in McArthur Court during their priority hour. A packet will be made up at that time. Because of the number of late packet requests, a delay of up to two hours may be experienced.

When and where do I sign up?

Registration for most courses is Monday, June 19 in McArthur Court. You must register during or after your priority hour. Your priority hour is based on the last four numbers of your social security number.

Undergraduate, full-time--12 to 21 credit hours, tuition is \$249.00.
