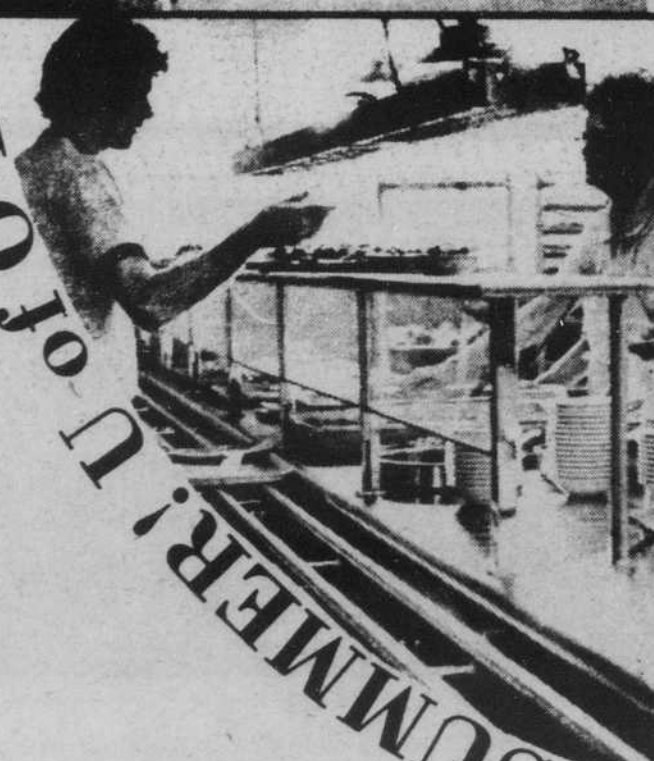




LIVE FREELY WITH FRIENDS

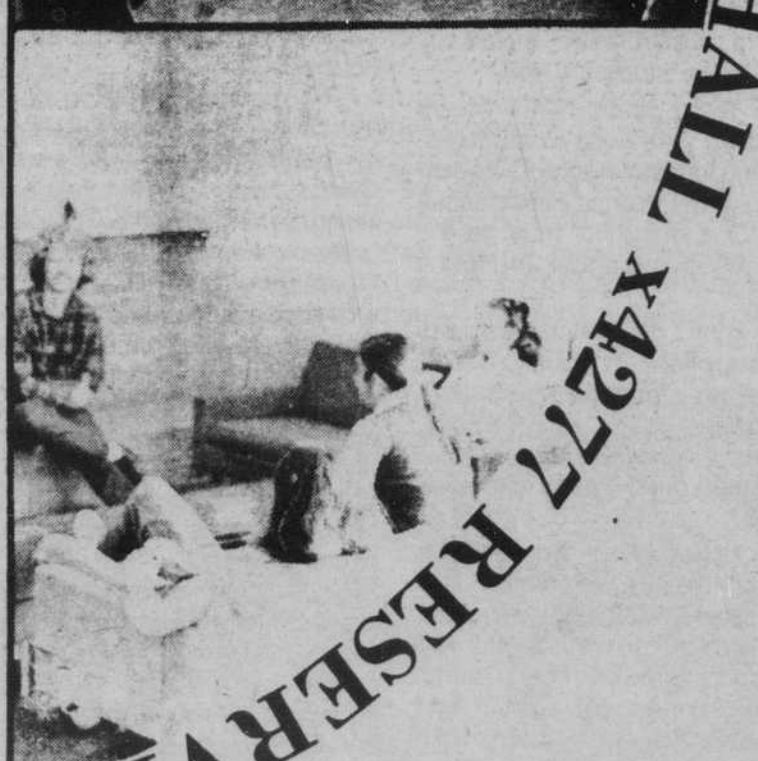
For students wishing additional privacy, single rooms are available upon request. In addition to privacy, single rooms offer expanded closet space and are furnished with a comfortable lounge chair.
