BRING site relocates

The BRING Recycle Station has moved to the parking lot located on 15th Avenue behind the University's Agate street offices.

The purpose of the move was to reduce automobile traffic in the campus area. The new site is ready for public use. However, materials brought to the original location will not be picked up for recycling, according to University Survival Center representatives.

Civic center vote coming up

A little more than a year since it was formed, the Civic Center Commission will be taking its cause to the polls in Tuesday's special election. That cause could put Eugene on the national and concert and performance map.

The commission, formed last year by the Eugene city council, will be offering an \$18.5-million Civic Center project to city voters Tuesday, with hopes that the project will be approved.

The center will consist of a Civic Auditorium, a combined concert hall and theater that will seat nearly 2,500 people. A community theater with seating for 500 people, underground parking, plazas, rehearsal and recital rooms and exhibition halls will also be a part of the center.

Although the center was to be part of a hotel-convention complex, the civic center commission has not made that part of the package to be presented to voters.

If the center is approved by voters, construction could begin as early as January, 1979. The economic impact of the center could provide nearly 1,200 construction-related jobs and some 130 full and parttime operational jobs.

City bonds will be issued only as the costs of the center increase and the city will explore alternative ways to fund the project once the complex is approved.

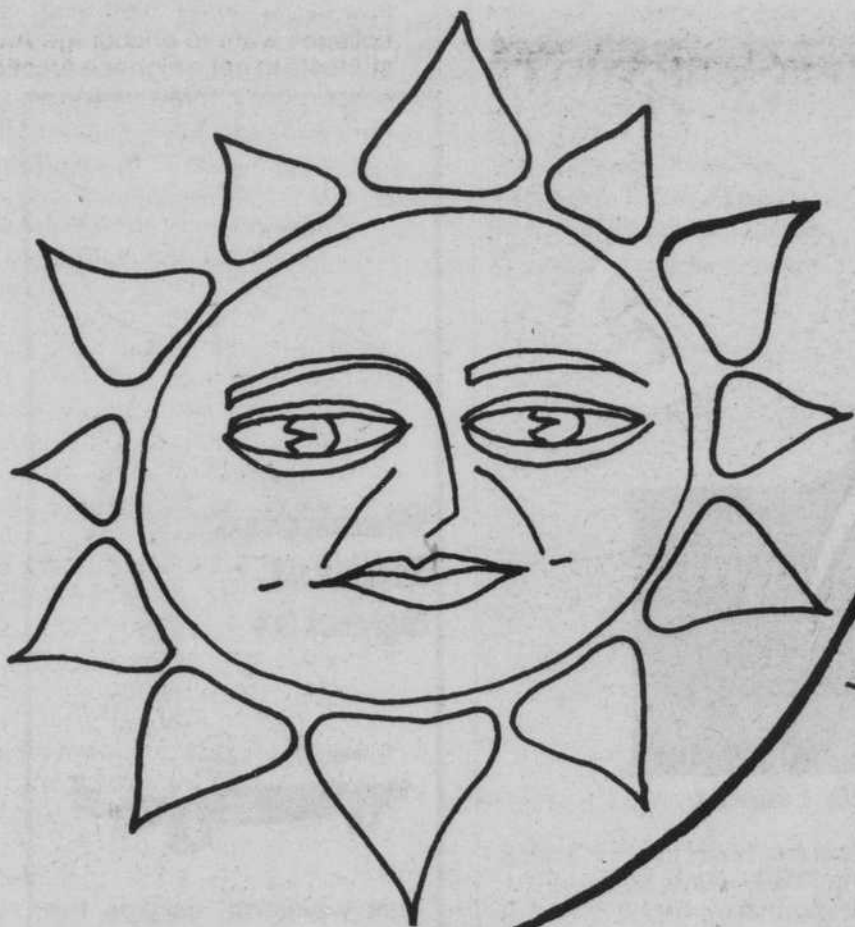
