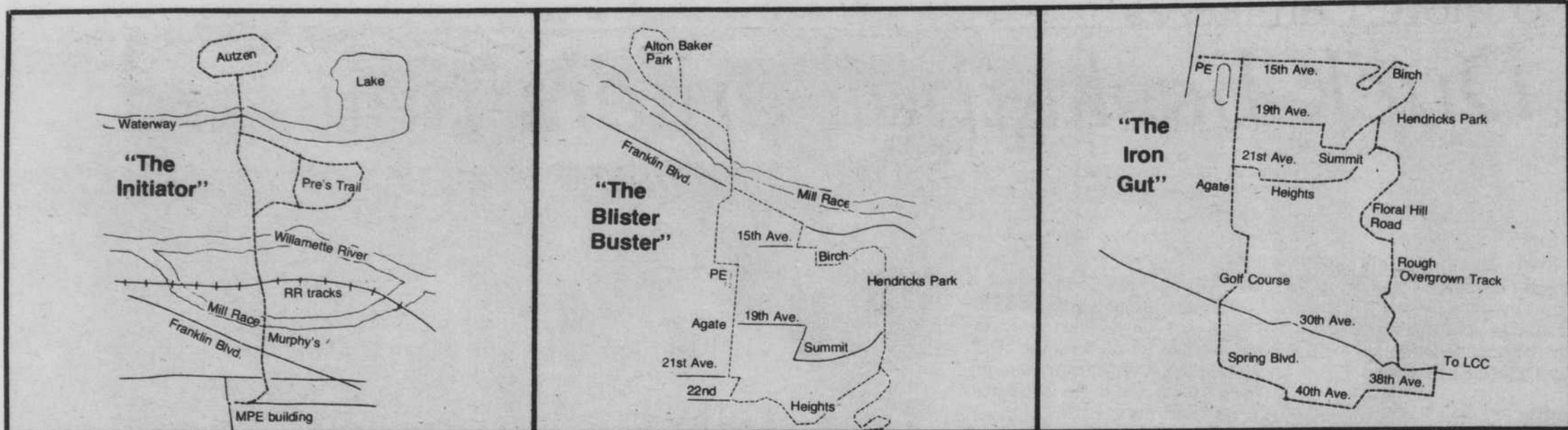




These three trails have been developed for people who aren't familiar with the area but want to do some jogging.

Multitude of facilities available

Varsity sports capture the eyes of thousands, as fans fill McArthur Court, Autzen Stadium, Howe Field, and Hayward Field.

But participation sports capture the arms and legs of almost every University member, and the area abounds with facilities for the athletically inclined.

BASKETBALL

McArthur Court, and the PE courts in Esslinger and Gerlinger Annex are often open in the afternoons and evenings for pick-up games. Three outside courts are

located on Agate Street in front of Walton Complex, and six more are located by the student parking lot on 15th Avenue across from Bean Complex. Two more outdoor courts can be found on 15th Avenue between Walton and Earl complexes.

BOWLING

Sixteen lanes are available in the evenings and weekends in the basement of the EMU.

SWIMMING

Leighton Pool, adjoining Esslinger Hall, is open during the noon hour, at night and on weekends. Gerlinger Pool, on the first floor of Gerlinger is also open

during the week. Call 686-4110 for specific schedules for either pool.

TENNIS

Covered courts are located on 15th Avenue, next to Esslinger. Outdoor courts are located on 16th Avenue and Alder Street, and on 15th Avenue between Walton and Earl complexes.

WEIGHTLIFTING

A special room in Esslinger houses an assortment of weightlifting apparatus.

GOLFING

There are 14 golf courses in Lane County, and seven of them

are in Eugene. A favorite course for those with a free afternoon is Tokatee, which is on the McKenzie Highway near Blue River.

FRISBEE

Just about any of the lawns on campus are adequate for playing frisbee, and Alton Baker Park on the Willamette is a favorite for frisbee flingers.

RUNNING

One of the best tracks in the world, Hayward Field is located at the corner of 15th Avenue and Agate Street. Just west of it is a P.E. track that can be used. Pre's Trail consists of trails of varying lengths and begins behind Autzen Stadium.

TEAM SPORTS

Fields behind the library, and behind Hayward Field are open for softball, football, and any other activity.

RACQUETBALL HANDBALL

Several courts are located near the covered tennis courts on 15th Avenue, and several more are located in Esslinger Hall.

Equipment rooms in Esslinger and Gerlinger Halls loan out all of the necessary equipment to students with valid fee cards. Showers are also available at both locations.



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
