

Program sets classes

Northwest Outward Bound School announces the opening of enrollment for its 1979 schedule of courses.

The schedule begins with the first winter course at the end of December and will include more than 30 separate programs involving ski mountaineering, river-running and summer mountaineering in wilderness areas of Washington, Oregon and Idaho.

Northwest Outward Bound School is a non-profit, educational organization, providing challenging programs in the forests, mountains and rivers of Oregon, Washington and Idaho. The

school conducts 21- and 24-day courses for men and women over age 16, and week-long courses designed to meet the interests and physical capabilities of adults 21 and over.

The mountaineering adventure course provides instruction in wilderness camping, mountaineering and rock climbing. Participants are confronted with challenges that require achievement and group cooperation.

Soap star juggles alter-egos

NASHVILLE, Tenn. (AP) — Can an art student turned singer find happiness as a soap-opera doctor?

For Michael Storm the saintly Dr. Larry Wolek on ABC's "One Life to Live," the answer is an unqualified yes.

"I've been known by two names for 10 years. I'm getting used to it," Storm said, recalling how he got lost once at night in Washington and was walked back to his hotel by two guys who recognized him as his soap-opera alter-ego.

"Being recognized can be a nice feeling."

Storm didn't start out to be a

doctor, or even an actor. During his college years, he studied art and picked up extra money singing and playing guitar. Then he went on to be part of the "Good-time Singers" in the 1960s.

"Our opening night was the Friday after President Kennedy was assassinated," he said.

In 1969, Storm landed the role of Dr. Wolek. But real life, like soap-opera perils, has its headaches.

"The viewers notice everything, yet the show is written like they notice nothing. It's especially frustrating," Storm said in an interview.

Agreeing with him was Susan Lucci, who portrays nasty ol' Erica Kane on ABC's "All My Children."

Storm and Ms. Lucci, along with Nick Benedict, who is Phil Brent on "All My Children," and Bill and Susan Hayes, who play Doug and Julie Williams on NBC's "Days of Our Lives," were at Opryland theme park recently as part of a traveling soap opera festival.

Ms. Kane said soap operas are becoming increasingly popular, partially because such notables Mrs. Lillian Carter, President Carter's mother, now admit they watch the daytime dramas.
