As might be expected, these mattresses cost considerably more. One store refuses to sell them separately, others charge from \$108 to \$149 for the baffle alone or will add \$90 to the price of the package, compared to the basic \$50 to \$60 for the lap seam.

The other main entry on the market is known as "the hybrid." It looks like a conventional mattress, comes in conventional mattress sizes and is considerably lighter than regular waterbeds.

The varieties don't stop there. The industry is trying to market a crib-size bed and an air float system, which attempts to cut wave

Trojan hearings resume quietly

SALEM (AP) — A federal hearing on the structural safety of the Trojan nuclear power plant resumed today without incident.

The federal board conducting the hearing decided that some testimony by Portland General Electric Co. cannot be given during the current session of the hearing.

The decision Monday was based in part on the utility's failure to provide enough advance notice regarding the existence of potential problems involving safety-related equipment at the plant, the board said.
