

In 15-minute talk show

KWAX debuts environmental show

"Earththoughts," a new talk show on environmental issues, will be broadcast from KWAX-FM at 91.1, starting Thursday.

Moderated by Mark Swancutt, a University senior in telecommunications, the show will air Thursday mornings at 9:30 for 15 minutes.

"I'm going to try to deal with air pollution, water quality, land use, noise problems and endangered species from a controversial

viewpoint," Swancutt explains. "Being a native Oregonian, you're brought up being concerned about the environment. The show is a good opportunity to discuss that concern."

"Earththoughts" is a brainchild of KWAX public affairs director Mike Moskovitz, who is in the process of developing several regular radio features with talk formats.

"The show might be syndicated around the state to both commercial and non-commercial sta-

tions," Moskovitz says. "It depends on how successful it is."

Swancutt will discuss the Alton Baker Park master land-use plan update with University Survival Center Director Jim Stratton on the first "Earththoughts" show Nov. 2.

Swancutt believes the show can be more effective if he leaves scheduling open. "Future shows will depend on what happens," he says. "I want to be able to include spur-of-the-moment issues."

The new programs will focus on the community at large as well as the student community. Swancutt encourages individuals or representatives of organizations with environmental concerns to contact him at KWAX.

Other shows filling the 9:30 a.m. spot Monday through Friday starting November 1 include: "Prime Time," a talk show for and about senior citizens on Monday mornings; "The Other Side," the Tuesday offering on alternative sports

(women's sports, soccer, hockey, etc.); "Don't Fence Me In," a look at issues, events and organizations for women; "Earththoughts," the Thursday environmental program, and "Art Access," the Friday show that ran last year featuring conversations with local artists about their works and local galleries.

KWAX will also run daily five-minute discussions at 11:55 a.m. of state ballot measures from now until Nov. 6.

Moskovitz reads a "Consumer Capsule" weekdays at 11:30 a.m. with two minutes of practical tips on home insulation, smoke detectors, rental practices, home canning, and other topics.

National Public Radio's news show, "All Things Considered," can be heard Monday through Friday on KWAX from 5 p.m. to 6:30 p.m., and on Saturday and Sunday from 5 p.m. to 6 p.m.

The station's air staff is mainly paid students. Management is drawn from the faculty staff.

Moskovitz suggests interested students contact him if they would like to work at KWAX in the music library or with program scheduling. Credit is available, as well as work-study payment. Moskovitz can be reached at 686-4236.
