

Straub predicted he would spend another \$33,000 in the final days. The two spent \$285,000 altogether in the May primary election.

Atiyeh and Straub spent a total of \$536,000 four years ago when Straub defeated the Beaverton carpet merchant to win his first term.

The reports filed Tuesday cover general election income and spending as of Oct. 26.

Atiyeh has received \$17,500 from the National Republican Governors Campaign Committee in Washington, D.C.

His other large donors include

Georgia-Pacific Corp., Portland, \$8,550; Seneca Sawmill Co., Eugene, and Rosboro Forest Products, Springfield, \$5,000 each; Weyerhaeuser Co., \$4,100, and Joint Council of Teamsters, Portland, \$4,000.

Straub's major contributors include the AFL-CIO's Committee on Political Education, \$8,423; Western Pacific Leasing Co., Portland, \$5,800; Machinists Union Non-Partisan Political League of Oregon, \$5,200; United Auto Workers Political Action Committee, Bell, Cal., \$5,000, and a brother, F.H. Straub of Port Arthur, Tex., \$4,000.
