that has yet to see print after four months. Herrera also concedes that his office has had some "staff communications problems."

"Several times we have had di-

rectives issued without my approval or knowledge," says Herrera. "We have to sit down and talk about improvements. We've leaned too much in the area of just sending out memos."

Herrera feels that his administration got a slow start partly because of his predecessor, Gary

Feldman.

"I only spent half an hour after the election with Gary, going over what he did in his administration," says Herrera. "It just wasn't enough time. When I leave office I want to help the next person more than I was helped."

Jeff Warren, ASUO vice presi-

dent for state and federal affairs, agrees.

"Ramon was coming in without a really solid grasp of what was going on in Suite 4," says Warren, who lost the ASUO presidency to Herrera in a runoff election last spring. "However, he has reinstalled a sense of confidence in the

ASUO. For example, we now have a much better relationship with the Incidental Fee Committee than Feldman did.

Herrera will concentrate on avoiding the traditional lack of energy that has accompanied past ASUO administrations during winter and spring terms.
