

# EWEB elects board president but fails to agree on procedure

New and old members of the Eugene Water and Electric Board split 3-2 on the need for specific rules of procedure, and John Tiffany was re-elected EWEB board president at Monday night's meeting.

Commissioners Jack Craig and John Bartels were elected last November on planks that included anti-nuclear positions. Their victories were controversial, as EWEB owns 30 percent of the Trojan nuclear power plant.

Bartels and Craig had been expected by some to join with current Commissioner Cammilla Pratt in forming a new majority on the board.

Pratt, who also expressed concerns over nuclear power in her race two years ago, however, joined commissioners Tiffany and Richard Freeman in tabling two motions by Craig and Bartels.

The first motion required the adoption of specific rules of procedure for the board. The board now operates on an "informal" basis.

Bartels said he was uncomfortable with "no road map to know how we're going to proceed."

Pratt, Tiffany and Freeman said they were satisfied with current board operating procedures, but agreed with the two new board members that a study was called for. They then tabled the motion in a 3-2 vote.

The second motion by Bartels and Craig was to change the meeting day of the board so it does not conflict with Eugene City Council meetings held the second and fourth Mondays of each month.

It was also tabled for study by a 3-2 vote.

Later in the meeting it was agreed informally to

have the staff report back at the next regular board meeting their study of the two questions raised.

Finally, the board moved to its first major agenda item — the election of officers.

Tiffany opened by saying he "would be pleased" to continue serving as board president. Bartels, however, nominated Pratt.

"The tenure of the current president is too long and it is time for a change," Bartels said.

Pratt declined to be nominated and instead nominated Tiffany. Again, a 3-2 split surfaced as Tiffany was re-elected board president.

Bartels then said he would not participate in the election of board vice president or representatives to the Lane Council of Governments (L-COG) and the Lane Council on Water.

"We have no operating procedures," said Bartels, adding, "I don't know what the duties of the vice president are. I find it impossible to vote on these positions."

Pratt was elected vice president with three votes. Bartels and Craig abstained from voting. L-COG and Lane Council on Water representatives will be selected at the Feb. 5 meeting.

Prof. John Reynolds, former EWEB board member, was supportive of the questioning of both Craig and Bartels.

General Manager Keith Parks said Craig lacked information because he had not yet attended an orientation session with EWEB staff.

Although Pratt supported Tiffany and Freeman Monday evening, she re-emphasized her agreement with Bartels and Craig in their opposition to nuclear power.

"I would never vote for any positive involvement of this utility with nuclear power."
