

Old County jail to stay in business

The Lane County Commissioners voted 4-1 Wednesday to accept a \$133,000 jail remodeling plan that will allow at least one more year's use of the old Lane County jail.

With commissioner Vance Freeman dissenting, the board accepted one of four options presented them by Lane County Sheriff David Burks in a work session last week.

On Wednesday the commissioners accepted an option that will allow the old jail to house 72 inmates while construction takes place of the third floor of the new Lane County jail.

The plan was designed to reduce overcrowding of both buildings, and will allow for additional housing to accommodate a 10-12 percent increase in the jail population per year.

Because the plans for the option have already been drawn, Burks says a building permit for the remodeling will be issued by the city of Eugene.

Burks told the commissioners Wednesday that Vik Construction Co. gave a final estimate at \$132,852.00.

The commissioners also asked Burks for the percentage of the building the city uses and what percentage the county and city jointly own for the facility.

Burks said the city used an average of

more than seven beds per day during 1978, but their required use varies from a low of four on Fridays to a high of 11 on Saturdays.

County Administrator Stan Biles told the commissioners that in his preliminary discussions with the city last month that the city refused to pay any of the remodeling costs.

In a Tuesday work session, the county commissioners decided to begin a search for a permanent general administrative officer.

The commissioners agreed to advertise the position, with an annual salary range of \$32,000 to \$43,000, in two West Coast jobs publications.
