

Waterway panel goes non-profit

The Emerald Canal Committee, the group that wants to build a 12-mile waterway flowing from the Millrace to Fern Ridge Reservoir, decided Wednesday to become a non-profit corporation entitled the Emerald Waterways Citizens Committee Inc.

Status as a non-profit corporation will enable EWCC to perform the numerous tasks required to guide the massive project to completion.

EWCC also decided to request the Eugene City Council and the Lane County Commissioners begin application procedures to obtain the water rights for the canal.

EWCC legal advisor Mike Williams said construction of the Emerald Canal, which would link the Millrace with the Amazon Slough, would divert water from the Willamette River at the rate of 200 feet per second.

EWCC co-chairer Charles Porter announced that the commissioners had voted unanimously Tuesday in favor of a resolution supporting the Emerald Canal's construction. The city council has ratified a similar resolution.

Preliminary estimates place the cost of the project between \$12 million and \$19 million. EWCC members are searching for both public and private sources funding for the project.

Porter said that at the committee's first public meeting two weeks ago at least part of the Emerald Canal could be financed through voter approval of a countywide general obligation bond issue.

Once the canal has been constructed and "the water is flowing," the anticipated rise in property values on the canal's banks will attract considerable private investment, Porter said.
