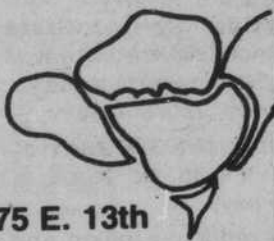

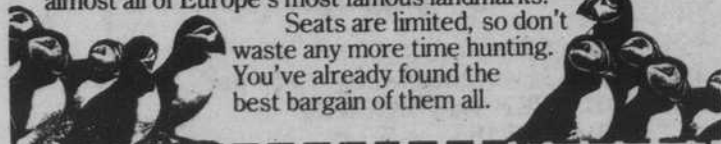

'Lewdness' charge threatens city's only adult bookstore

Adult film devotees are waiting on hold while a Lane County Circuit Court judge decides whether to close Eugene's only adult bookstore and movie arcade.

Judge Edwin Allen will rule on the fate of Adult World, 490 E. Broadway, some time this week, pending the outcome of a civil suit that would permanently end the establishment's business.

In the suit, filed last month, Lane County District Attorney Pat Horton charged that Adult World is the site of "lewd activity," particularly in the movie arcade section. Twenty-four coin-operated movie projectors are in the arcade.

Seven Eugene Police Department undercover agents have filed affidavits testifying they wit-

nessed more than 40 acts of lewdness between male patrons of the establishment in the course of a three-week investigation last month.

Adult World is charged with establishing and maintaining a place where lewdness occurs. The suit seeks to close the business as a public nuisance.

Owner-manager Dale Anderson of Eugene has denied the business was established for the purpose of lewdness, and also claimed he was unaware of any acts of lewdness taking place there.

Under cross examination, however, Anderson admitted taking steps to facilitate such acts, including drilling a waist-high "glory hole" between booths.

Attorneys for Anderson, Robert Cox, Adult World bookkeeper,

and Thomas Shaw and Daniel Cossett (Portland owners of the Adult World property) contend that Adult World cannot be closed as a nuisance because the place where the acts allegedly took place are enclosed, private.

They further contend that no public nuisance exists because the alleged acts prompted no complaints from any citizen or public agency.

Police had been conducting an "on-and-off" investigation of Adult World since its opening in July, but were able to accelerate their probe when Jon Landre, a former clerk at Adult World, came to the police last November with business records about the bookstore.

Working with Landre's information, the undercover agents entered the movie arcade at various times, posing as patrons. According to testimony in the preliminary hearing, they observed more than 25 customers engaging in masturbation, oral and anal intercourse, and other allegedly lewd acts. Many of these acts were facilitated by the "glory holes." Anderson testified Friday that he became upset when he learned of the existence of one such hole and covered it with linoleum.

When questioned by Assistant District Attorney David Nissman, however, Anderson admitted that when he noticed the increased profits from the booths connected by the glory hole, he drilled another hole between two other booths.

During their investigation, police viewed the alleged acts through such holes or by peeking over the tops of the adjoining seven-foot walls.
