### Burdman gains responsibility for orientation

Robert Burdman has been named director of orientation at the University.

Burdman, 40, is former communication manager of the 767 program at the Boeing Company in Seattle. In his University position Burdman will have primary responsibility for the Early Orientation and Registration Program, the University's system for fall term entering freshmen to register and become acquainted with the campus during the summer before they begin their studies. He will also coordinate New Student Week and International Student Week.

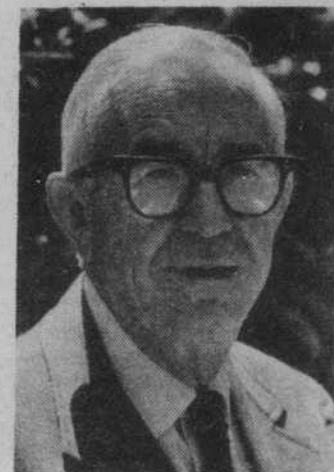
In addition to his tenure at Boeing, Burdman served as a consultant in organizational communications to the U.S. Agency for International Development in Costa Rica. He has taught at Oregon College of Education and Cleveland State University and served as the Loss Prevention and Audit Superintendent of the Puerto Rican American Insurance Co.

### History professor dies

Thomas Govan, professor emeritus of U.S. history, 72, died Monday at his home after a long illness. He joined the faculty in 1967 and retired in 1977.

Govan came to Oregon from New York University after serving at Brown, Emory, Tulane Universities and the Universities of Virginia, of the South, and Chattanooga University during a career that began in 1934.

A memorial service will be held at St. Mary's Episcopal Church, details are pending. Later there will be a memorial service in New York City. Burial will be in the churchyard of St. Mark's Church-in-the-Bowery, New York. Lounsbury-Musgrove Mortuary is handling funeral arrangements.
