Maggie Smith was chosen Best Supporting Actress for her role in "California Suite," and Christopher Walken won an Oscar for Best Supporting Actor in "The Deer Hunter."

Other nominees for Best Picture were "Coming Home," "An Unmarried Woman," "Heaven Can Wait" and "Midnight Express."

Vying for Best Actress along with Fonda were Ingrid Bergman in "Autumn Sonata," Elien Burstyn in "Same Time Next Year," Geraldine Page in "Interiors" and Jill Clayburgh in "An Unmarried Woman."
