Psych department ranks high on national level

The University's psychology department ranks tenth among programs in the United States, Canada and Great Britain according to the December 1978 issue of American Psychologist. That ranking comes on the strength of the department's faculty, says department head Robert Fagot, who characterizes faculty members as knowledgeable and equipped with the talents necessary to provide first-rate experiences to students. The ranking was based on size of departments' faculties and the number of times faculty

members were cited in psychological publications. The study ranked the University's psychology department above those of other prestigious institutions like Johns Hopkins, Columbia and Princeton universities. Fagot says the department works with a faculty that has remained virtually the same size since 1970 and \$2.5 million of funds drawn annually from both state and federal sources. The department's strengths, says Fagot, are "research, a good clinical program and cognitive psychology."
