## Reports criticized

**RANIER (AP)** - Workers at the Trojan nuclear plant say the news media is guilty of distorting the nuclear issue and making problems at nuclear plants seem worse than they really are.

As an example, several workers pointed to reports that reactor operators at Trojan were playing games and even sleeping on the job.

Bill Babcock, an auxiliary operator, said a reactor operator has nothing to do if the plant is operating normally. Company policy states that operators are supposed to read manuals during this free time.

"I'm not saying that it (the free time) wasn't abused," he said. "But a lot of what was leaked to the press was sour grapes."

The workers interviewed admitted an accident at the plant a year ago, in which two fellow workers suffered some of the most severe radioactive exposure on record at a nuclear plant, was a serious problem.
