education," Boe told him. "I can't give you a name and I don't personally know who. The way information comes to my office is through osmosis, but I'd suggest you go talk to the guy who lobbies for the State Board of Higher Education. My job is to put bills into committee. It's yours to get them out."

Stoddard Malarkey is the state board's legislative lobbyist. He denies having done anything to kill HB 2831, a position in apparent contradiction to Boe's.

"I was not aware of that," Malarkey said Friday when told of the move to send the course evaluation

proposal to ways and means. "I've been too busy worrying about projected budget cuts."

Malarkey cited several reasons why he opposes the bill but added, "I've promised the OSU I wouldn't lobby against it and I won't predict its death. It's just another hurdle it'll have to clear."

In the same conversation Malarkey was asked if the subsequent referral might leave the bill sitting in committee when the session ends. "I would tend to agree with that," he answered.

"The board's office didn't initiate that maneuver,"

Malarkey continued. "I don't know where it came from."

Yet the suggestion came from somewhere, leaving Jim Bernau, the OSU's executive director, to exclaim, "Someone's lying here and we're going to find out who it is."

Boe ended his meeting with the students on another note, pounding the arm of his chair rhythmically and warning, "don't be in such a god-awful hurry to get me to take that subsequent referral off the bill."

As he walked from the room, students were left with no option but to say "thank you."
