closest to the University being Amazon Pool at 2600 Hilyard St. It's a big pool with lots of space for sunning yourself, but it does get crowded on weekends.

Leighton pool, located next to the covered tennis courts on campus, is another possibility. It is covered and you can use the locker facilities next door in Esslinger Hall. For information on hours, call 686-4104.

One of the best swimming holes in the area is Wildwood Falls, south of Eugene. The setting is idyllic and the rock diving first-class. To get there, take I-5 south to Cottage Grove. Take the Cottage Grove-Dorena Lake exit and turn left toward Dorena Lake. Continue up Row River Road past Dorena Dam and through the towns of Dorena and Culp Creek. When the road forks, turn left at the fork in the road below Culp Creek. The falls is about a half-mile from the fork.

Closer to campus, you can go swimming in the Willamette along most of Skinners Butte Park, an easy two-mile bike ride from the campus. It's located on the south bank of the river and has barbecue and picnic facilities.

There are three golf courses fairly close to campus, each offering something different. Laurelwood, less

than a mile from the University, is extremely hilly with short fairways. Call 687-5321 for more information.

The Eugene Country Club offers an elegant setting for a round of golf in the Eugene area. Long tree-lined fairways and magnificently landscaped grounds highlight this golf course. It's for members only, though, whereas Laurelwood is open to the public. Call 345-0181 for more information.

Oakway Golf Course, over the Willamette near the Ferry Street Bridge, is another public golf course. Flat with smallish greens and fairways, it is a good course for the novice. If you want to find out more, call 484-927. **TENNIS AND RAQUETBALL**

Tennis buffs will go absolutely wild over the large number of tennis courts located near campus. Some of the best are probably the covered courts just above Hayward Field. They are lighted at night until about 11 p.m. and are well-maintained. In the same complex are six indoor racquetball/handball courts.

In the middle of campus near Carson Hall are a half-dozen outdoor courts which are used by the Oregon tennis team in competitive matches. There is another set of outdoor tennis courts near the music building paralleling Alder Street. They are not as well-maintained as the other outdoor courts but are adequate for beginners.

There are over a dozen racquetball/handball

courts in Esslinger Hall, open from 8 a.m.-4:30 p.m., Monday through Friday.

**BASEBALL AND SOFTBALL**

If you like to watch professional baseball, the Eugene Emeralds are for you. A farm team of the Cincinnati Reds, they play at Civic Stadium, just off 19th Avenue and Willamette Street. Their season extends into mid-August, and tickets are relatively inexpensive. For more information, call 342-5367.

If you would rather watch a bit less-refined brand of baseball, the Eugene Sports Program sponsors baseball and softball programs for boys and girls from grades three to nine. There's lots of action and you don't need a ticket to get into the ballpark. Call 683-2373 for a summer schedule.

The Eugene Parks and Recreation Department sponsors a variety of summer softball leagues, including men's, women's and coed clubs. If you're interested in participating, call 687-5333. **ETCETERA**
