

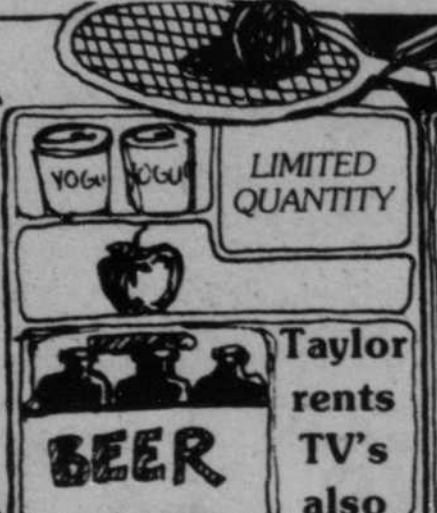

EMU Check Cashing Information

The Erb Memorial Union Main Desk Store cashes checks as a service for students, faculty and staff of the University of Oregon. Students must present a **current certificate of registration and a plastic identification card with picture**; faculty/staff must present their plastic identification card with picture and current validation sticker.

There is a fifteen cent service charge per check. Make checks payable to the Erb Memorial Union and include Eugene address and phone number (or department and extension for faculty/staff) on the check. The limit on checks is \$10.00 at all times unless otherwise posted.

When writing checks, double-check your bank balance, make sure what you think will be a "good check" doesn't turn out to be a "bad check." If your check is returned there is a service charge of \$5.00. This is addition to any service charge charged by your bank. You will also lose the privilege of cashing checks at the Erb Memorial Union for the remainder of the year (July 1 - June 30.)

To abide by policies set forth by banks: 1) We cannot accept counter checks. 2) There can be no alterations or changes made on checks. 3) We cannot accept personal second party checks and 4) If you do not have personalized checks, additional I.D. must be presented.
