Recent RCYB poster revives controversy

Posters announcing the visit of the communist party chief to Seattle were removed almost as quickly as they were put up last week.

Students who ventured on campus early Thursday morning were greeted by posters illegally posted on buildings, walls and posts by the Revolutionary Communist Party (RCP) and the Revolutionary Communist Youth Brigade (RCYB), but before the end of the day the posters had been spray painted or removed.

"We took the posters down

because they were illegally posted on buildings around campus," said Oakley Glenn, director of campus security. "The RCYB posters weren't the only posters removed, but they were the most controversial."

"We (campus security) took down the posters to comply with the city's posting regulations," Glenn said.

The defense fund contribution poster isn't the first illegally posted by the RCYB, said Scott Bassett, ASUO president. "The RCYB has repeatedly failed to comply with the University's posting policy — that lost them their ASUO recognition, and they have yet to reapply."

The RCYB poster controversy has flickered off and on for four years. The first poster — "We've carried the rich for 3,000 years, it's time to get them off our backs" — can still be seen pasted to walls around campus.

"The groups promised then to stop illegally pasting their posters," Bassett said, "but during the next school year posters appeared again."

The second time the RCYB struck, members used a special paste, but the group again promised to stop pasting the posters illegally.

Last term when posters supporting the Moody Park Three appeared on campus walls, the RCYB was suspended for its violations.

"There's really nothing the ASUO can do this time," Bassett said. "The RCYB's been suspended, but that's the worst thing the ASUO has the power to do."

The suspension left the RCYB without EMU privileges, but the group sidestepped the suspension by placing its pamphlets on the ground. "Unless they set up a table, they are not violating any rules," said then ASUO Pres. Ramon Herrera.

The latest violation won't get the RCYB suspended, but it could effect its reinstatement, Bassett said.

"They still have to petition the ASUO for reinstatement," he said. "I won't say this will hurt them, but we will obviously take it into consideration."
