Anti-nuke program airs August 7

The Trojan Decommissioning Alliance (TDA), which is involved in the fight to shut down the Trojan Nuclear Plant near Rainier, is sponsoring a television series entitled "Nuclear Questions."

The series is part of the public access programming on KOZY, cable channel 11. This service provides prime air time to groups and individuals for presenting their concerns to the general public.

Each of the four half-hour programs will be shown twice.

Tuesdays at 5:30 p.m. and Thursdays at 9:30 p.m. beginning Aug. 7.

The first week's schedule includes a discussion by Congressional aide Ron Eachus on the potential impact of the Jackson Northwest energy bill and the Weaver alternative bill. The next week, Aug. 14 and 16, TDA member Sandy Pitler will report on nuclear legislation within the state government. Elementary school children from Eugene's 4-J school district will also be interviewed the second week.

The third week, Aug. 21 and 23, will feature an interview with University molecular biologists George Streisinger and Frank Stahl, who will discuss low-level radiation exposure. The series will conclude with a discussion by members of the Alliance for Survival on the relationships between nuclear weapons and power industries in southern California, Aug. 28 and 30.
