Beam says he knows of several residents who own bunkbeds.

"All of the bunkbeds that I know of were built by people in the rooms," he says. "I don't think they're unsafe."



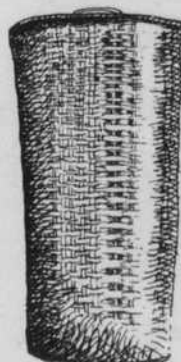
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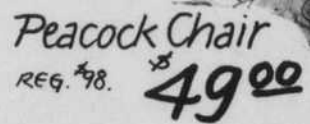
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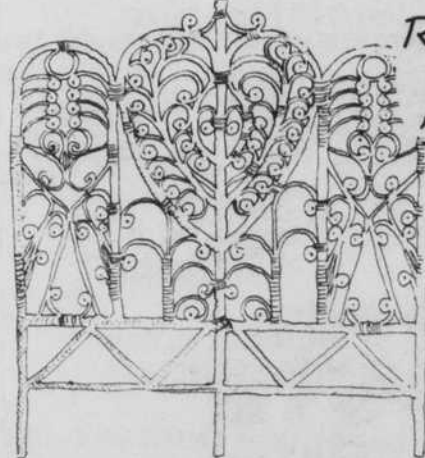
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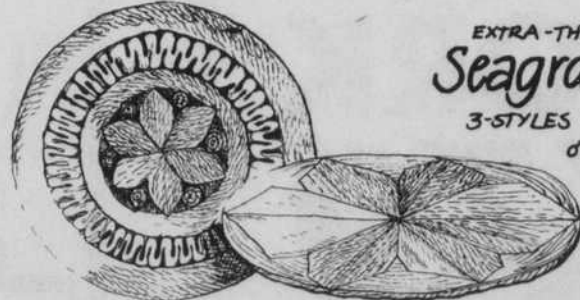
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
