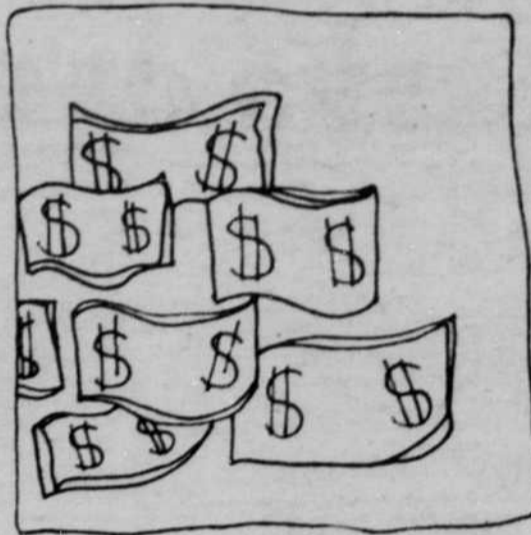
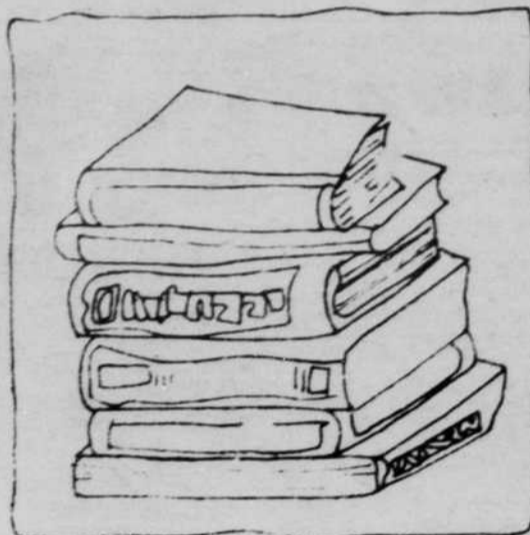

Our Buyback Policy:

1. You get half-price—

if a faculty member has ordered the book for the fall quarter. However, at times we have more books for a class than needed and we will not buy these books at the half price.

2. You get Dealer prices—

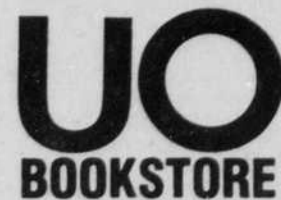
for those texts not needed on this campus. We'll pay the price offered by book dealers, which is based on the need for the book in the national market.

3. We do not accept—

old editions, spiral-bound books, programmed texts, certain inexpensive paperbacks, workbooks, most consignment material, and extensively cribbed or damaged books. They are of no value to us or the used book dealers. We purchase such books only at our option.

When to sell your books—

The buyback counter, located upstairs, is open during regular business hours. It's not necessary to wait for a specific buying period to resell your books. However, the best service can be had during the above time period because we have arranged with the wholesale book company to have their buyers at the Bookstore on these dates.
