The program, housed in the Psychology Clinic in Straub Hall, will offer group treatments for smokers of moderate to high

nicotine cigarettes beginning the week of Jan. 21.

According to program director Edward Lichtenstein, only treatments believed effective are used to help smokers stop smoking.

"The six-week programs we are about to offer are unique in

that they focus on helping smokers stay off cigarettes once they have quit," he says.

Appointments for brief pre-treatment interviews and further information about the smoking control program may be obtained by calling the program office at 686-4903.

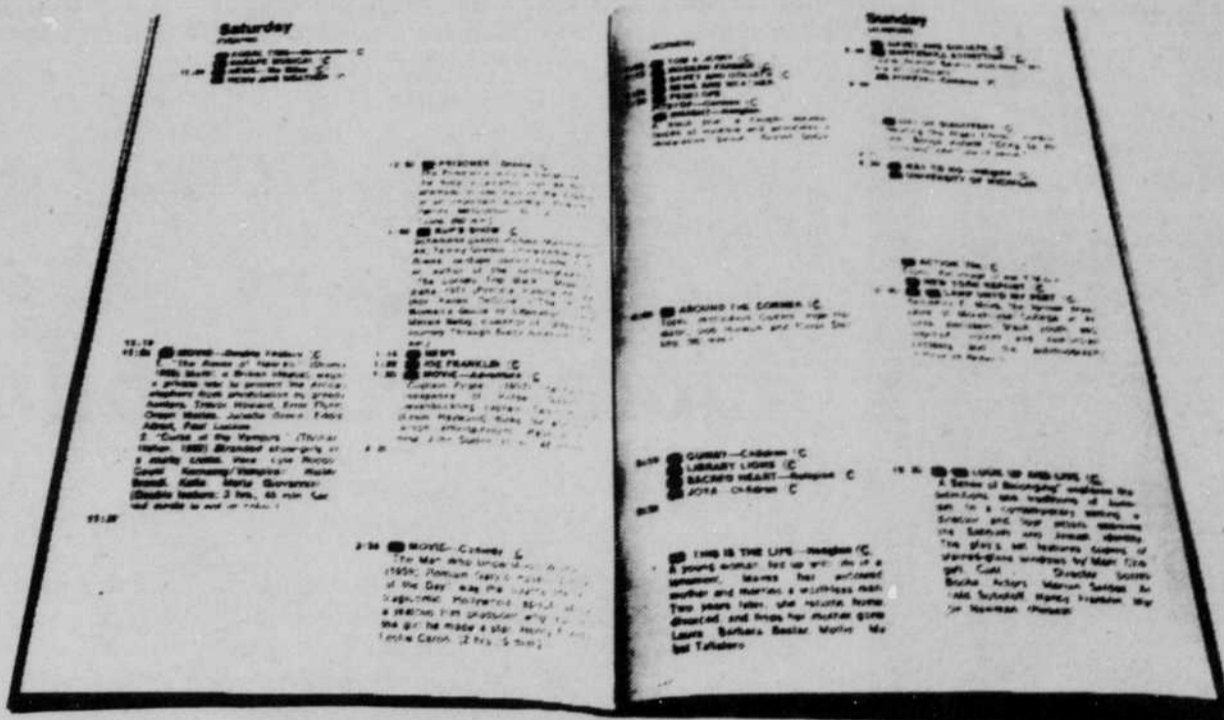
