Black-and-white and color photos of the American landscape by photographer William Garnett of Napa Valley, Calif., are on display at the Photography at the Oregon Gallery in the University Museum of Art through Feb. 3.

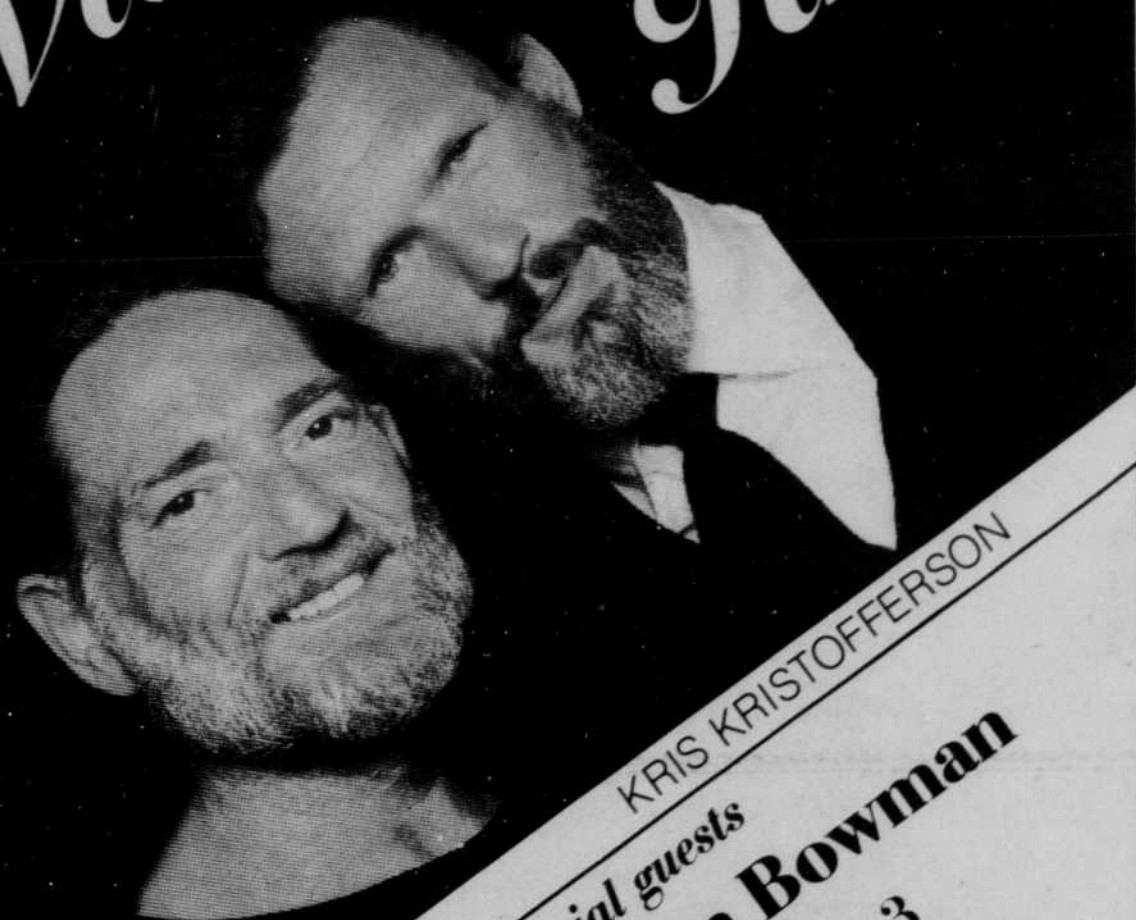
"For over 25 years, he (Garnett) has captured magnificent
