• March 3 — "Teach Me To Dance" — A drama designed to deal with the impact of ethnic prejudices on the relationships of two children.



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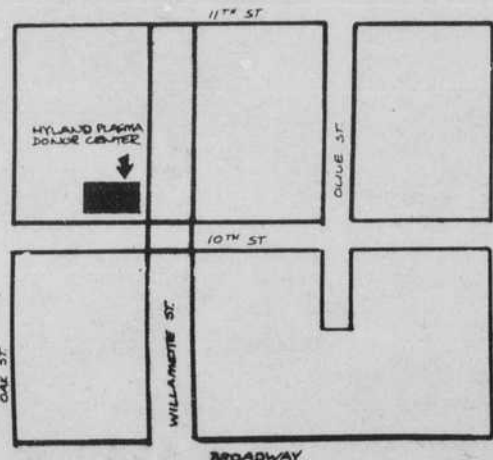

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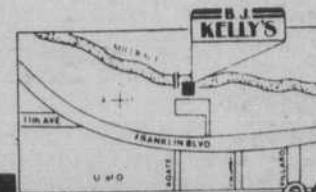
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
