

Drugs, alcohol don't mix, says sheet

The University Drug Information Center's newest fact sheet explores various aspects of alcohol use, including its production, physiological and psychological effects, legal aspects, responsible use and common interactions with drugs.

According to the fact sheet, alcohol figures heavily into traf-

fic fatalities, child abuse, crime rates, home and industrial accidents, job absenteeism and suicides.

"Studies to date indicate the majority of adults and teenagers are using alcohol for recreation or enjoyment."

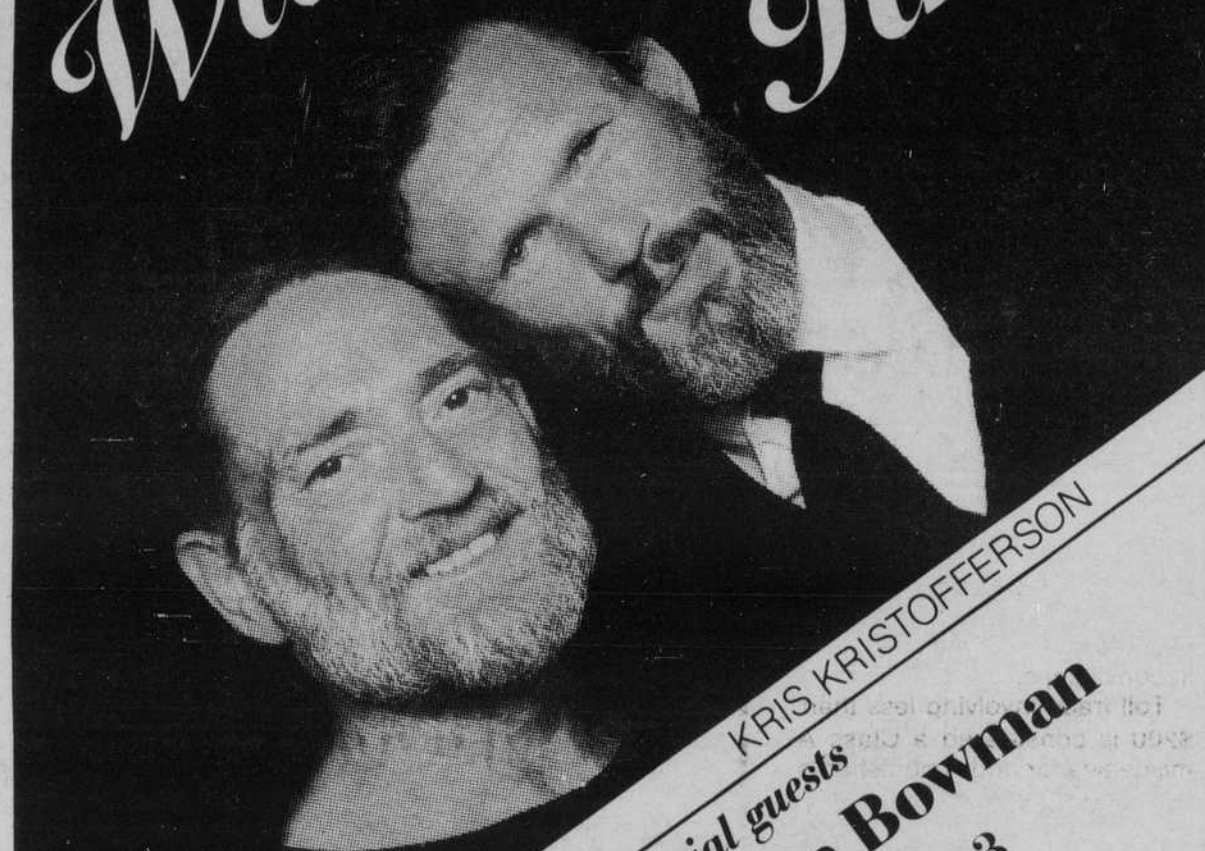
The fact sheet also lists various agencies in Lane County

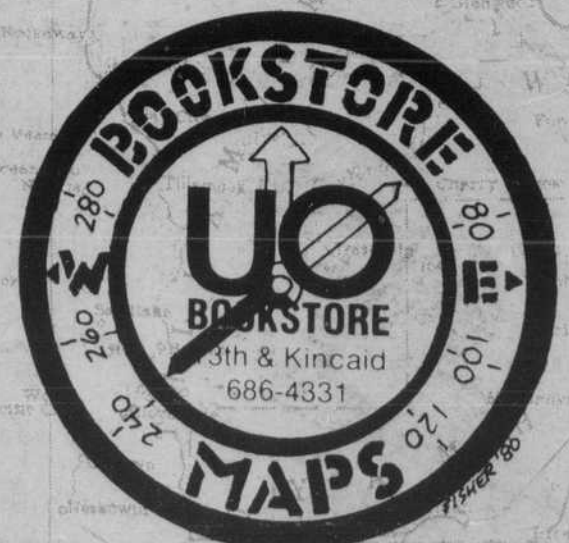
