All libraries will close at 5 p.m. Friday, March 14. Between-terms hours will be Monday through Friday, 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.

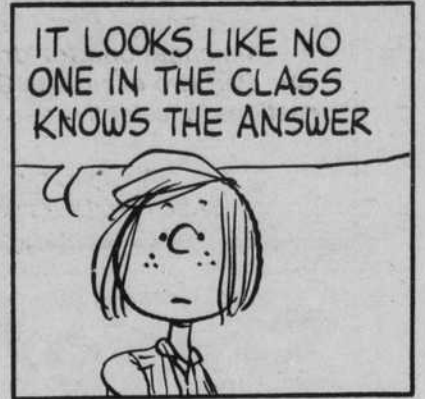

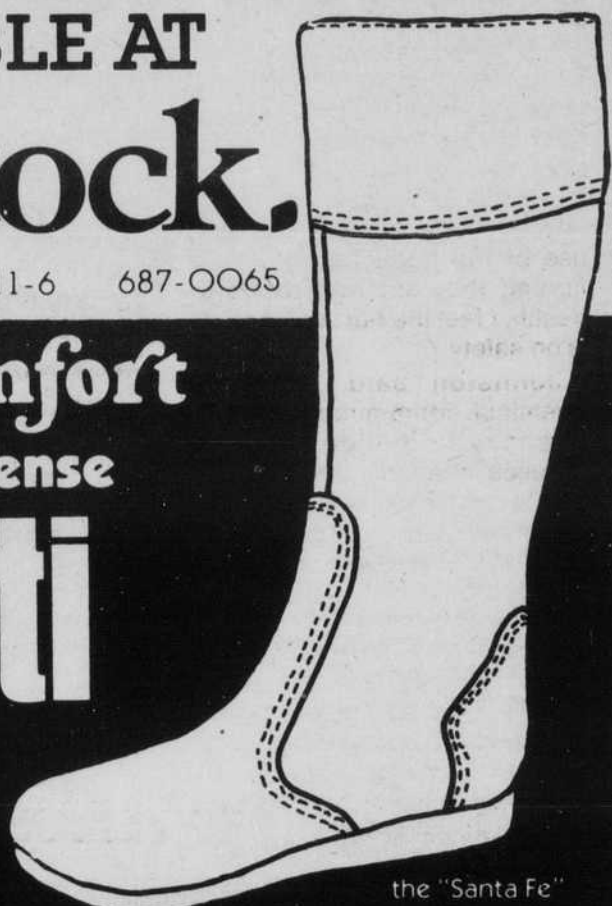
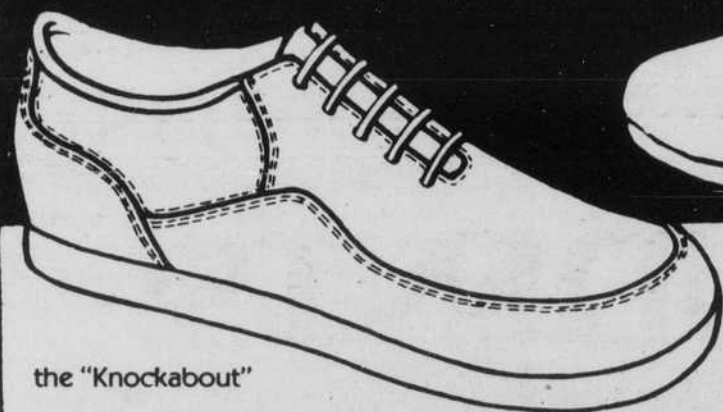
