Hatfield to speak at graduation

Sen. Mark Hatfield will be the featured speaker at the University's spring term commencement ceremonies Sunday, June 8.

Some 1,968 degree candidates will be eligible to participate in the ceremonies to be held at 2:30 p.m. outdoors at Hayward Field.

In his address, "Foreign Policy in the '80s: Challenge to Peace," Hatfield is expected to

examine and discuss the current state of world affairs, including conflicts over natural resources.

One of the earliest opponents to the Vietnam War, Hatfield maintains a keen interest in foreign affairs. He serves on the subcommittee funding U.S. foreign assistance programs. He is a congressional leader in efforts to combat world hunger and raise human rights issues.
