

Credit offered for aides to muscular dystrophy office

Students interested in receiving upper division sociology course credit for 406 supervised field work may apply for one of six student aide positions at the Muscular Dystrophy Association.

The MDA, located at 56 E. 15th Ave., is a nationwide, private, non-profit health care organization for the treatment of and the search for cures for 40 different neuromuscular diseases.

People applying for the student aide positions must have upper division status at the University, a valid Oregon driver's license and preferably access to a car (mileage will be reimbursed). They will perform a variety of duties including considerable public contact and paperwork. They should be able to work comfortably with many kinds of people, including disabled persons.

The aide positions provide practical job experience for anyone interested in physical therapy or health-related fields.

To apply, drop by the sociology department, 736 PLC, and pick up an application. Applicants will be asked to write a brief statement on why they're applying. Applications will close Friday.

Applicants may register for three credit hours, which means six to nine hours of work per week, or for six credit hours — 15-18 hours of work per week.

Aides will be supervised by Benton Johnson, sociology professor. A journal summarizing the field experience will be required for a grade.
