**Draft Counseling** is available through the Campus Christian Ministry and Parents Against Registration and the Draft. Call 686-3597 or 686-4694.

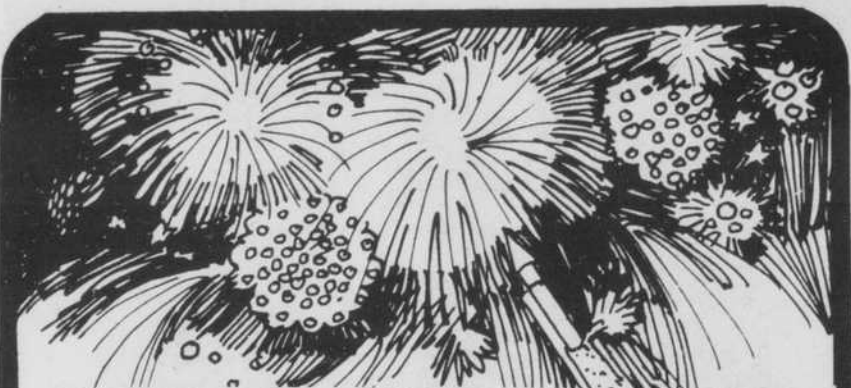

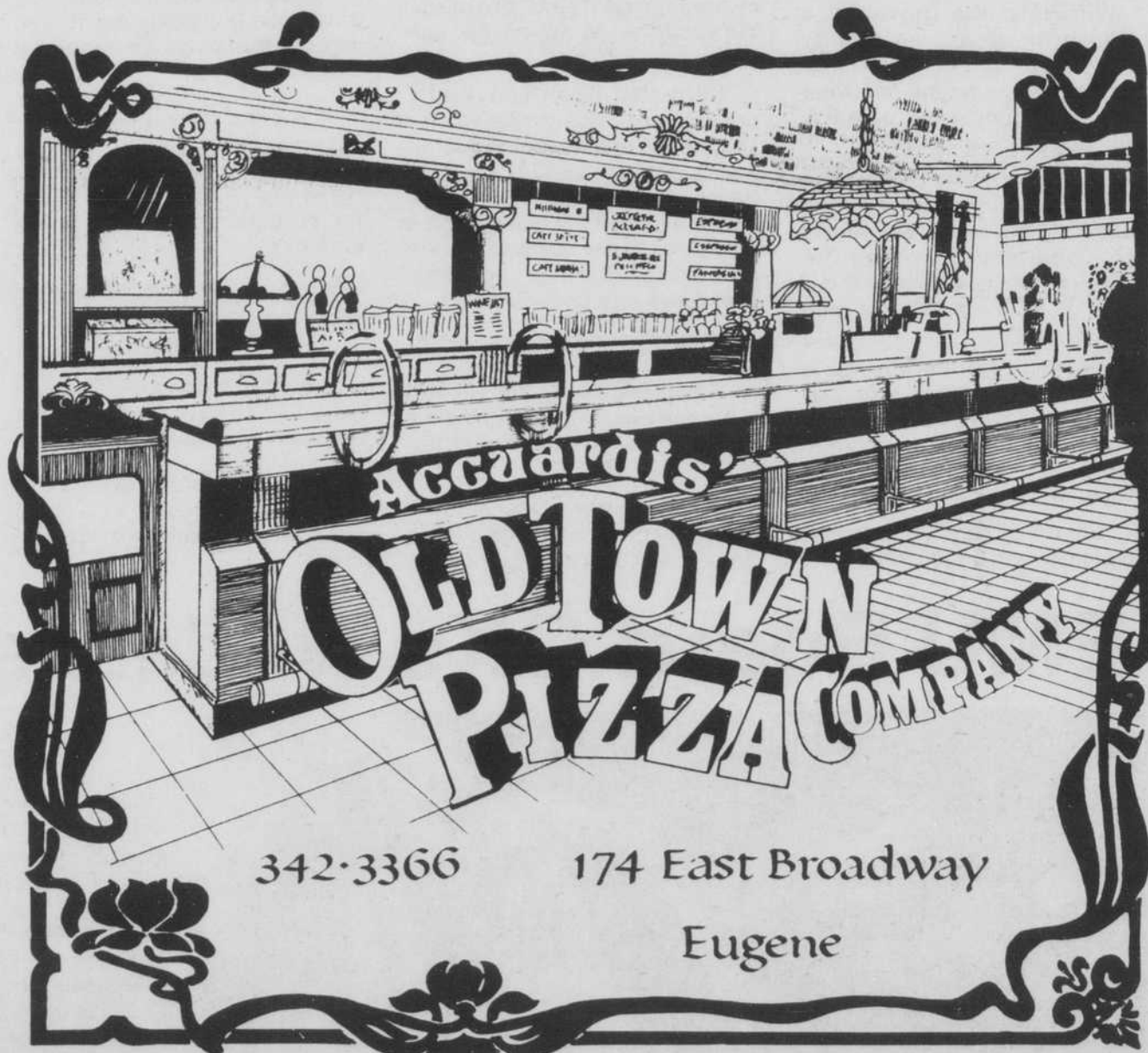
