Headquarters of the Lane County Democratic Party are located at 857 Willamette, with daily office hours. Under the leadership of county party chairer Bill Morrisette, the Democrats work to elect Democratic candidates and promote the principles of the party platform. Also active are the Young Democrats, a campus-oriented group.

On Oct. 4, the Democrats will hold their second annual "Donkey Trot" in Alton Baker Park. The event features three-mile and six-mile runs, with trophies awarded in all categories and T-shirts given to all participants.

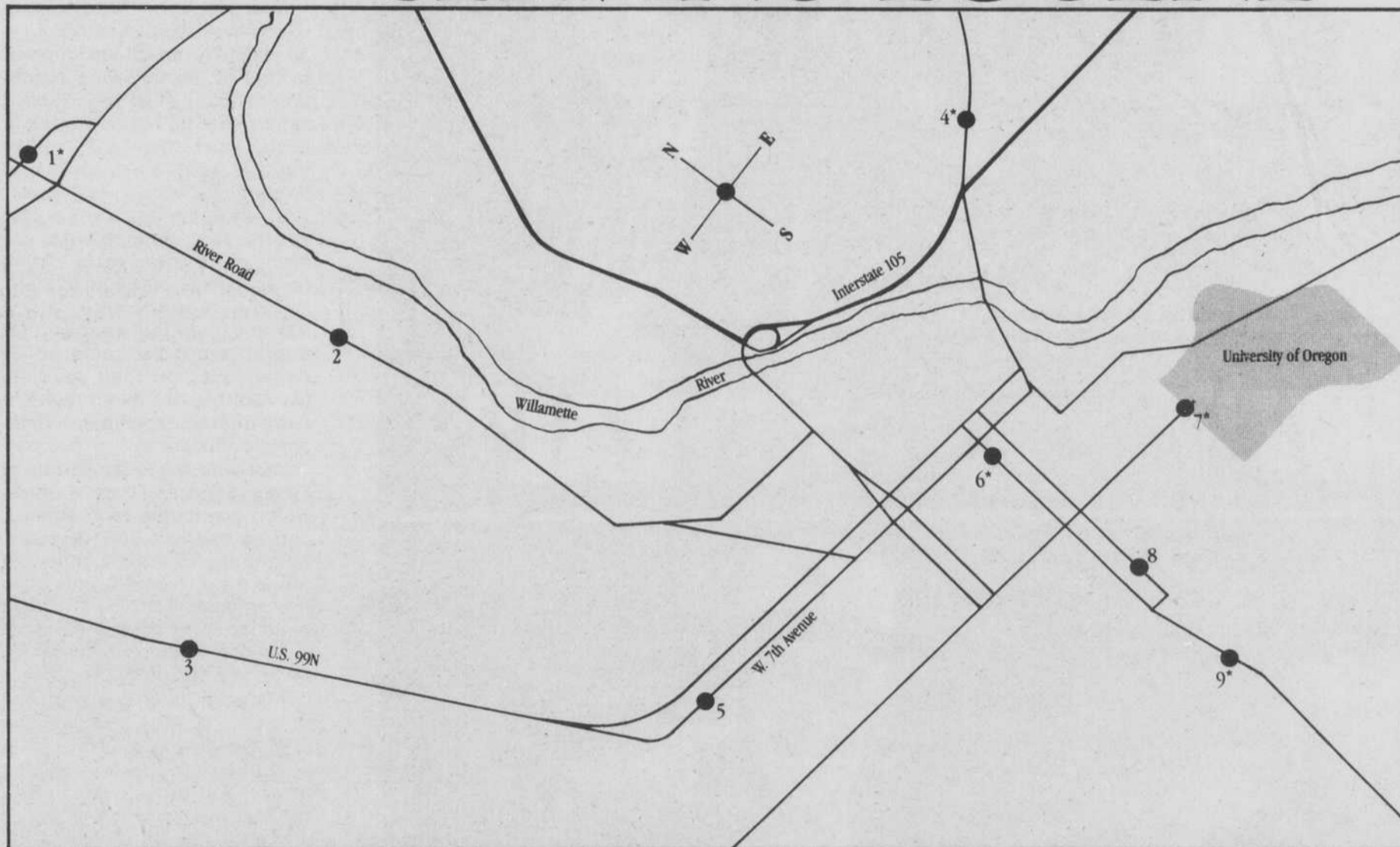
